Lincoln is situated upon the SE¼ of Section 23, the W½ of the NW¼ and the W½ of the SW¼ of Section 25 and Section 26 of Township No. 10N. of Range No. 6 East of the 6th Principal Meridian, and is located upon said described tracts of land by the undersigned Commissioners under and by virtue of an Act of the Legislature of the State of Nebraska, entitled "An Act to provide for the location of the seat of Government of the State of Nebraska, and for the erection of public buildings there at.

Approved June 14th, 1867.

Done at Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska, this 14th day of August A.D., 1867.

Stone monuments marked with a drill point are established at the intersections of the center lines of 4th, 7th, 10th, 13th, & 16th Sts. with all streets running East & West and in A. E. J. O. & S with all the sts. running North & South also at the center intersections of 15th & H, 15 & K, 8 & P, 9 & P, 8 & Q, 9 & Q also in 7th, 10th, & 14th at the intersection of the northern line of the northern tier of blocks. These monuments are marked upon the plat thus 0 7th, 9th, 11th, 15th, D. J. O. & S are 120 ft. wide, other streets are 100' wide. Alleys are 16 ft. wide.
