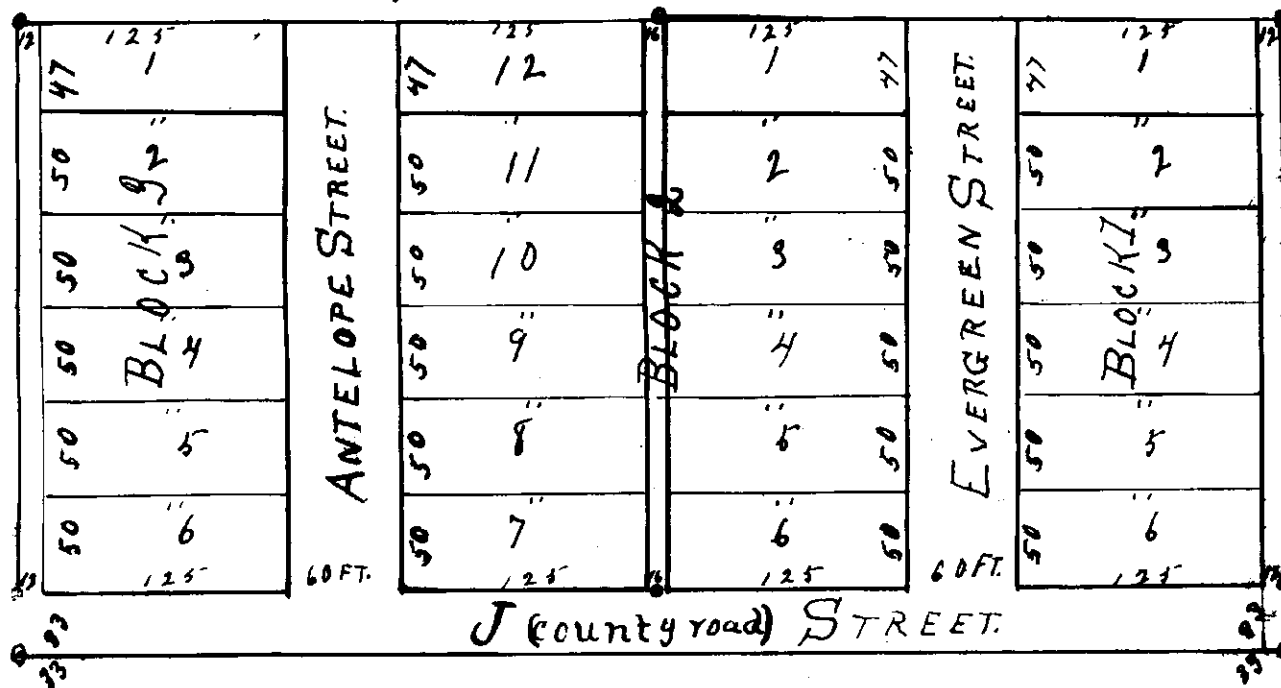

part of the $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the T.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 25
T. 10 R. 6, E. 6. P. 12. Beginning at the S.W. cor of said
 $\frac{1}{2}$ forty (40) rods north of the center of the
S line of the aforesaid N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$, and running east
on the line of the aforesaid N.E. $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$
forty (40) rods, then north parallel with the
West line of said S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ twenty (20) rods, then
West parallel with the South line of said N.E. $\frac{1}{2}$
forty (40) rods, to the W line of said S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$
then South on said line twenty (20) rods
to the place of beginning, to be surveyed and
staked out into lots, streets and alleys as appear
on the annexed plat, and the said subdivision
is with the free consent and according to the
desire of the undersigned sole owners
and proprietors of said land.
