CORPORATION WARRANTY DEED

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 21st day of September A.D., 1931 between Wall Street Mission of the Methodist Episcopal Church a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Iowa party of the first part, and The State of Nebraska of the second part,

WITNESSETH. That the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and no/100 (\$500.00) Dollars in hand paid, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has sold and by these presents does grant, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, the following described premises, situated in Dakota County, and State of Nebraska, to-wit:

All of a tract of land 100 feet wide and 414 feet long, across the east 400 feet of Lot 8, in the Northeast Quarter (NE_{1/4}) of Section 36, Township 29 North, Range 8 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian Dakota County, Nebraska, the center line of which is described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the east line of Lot 8, which is 926.6 feet southeasterly from the northeast corner thereof; thence on a straight line bearing South 74° 32' West a distance of 414 feet to a point on the west line of the east 400 feet of said Lot 8; the above-described tract containing 0.95 acres, more or less.
