owners of 1.55 Acs NE⁴

Section 8, Township 5 -N, Range LIV, FILMERE County, State of Nebraska, on behalf of self or themselves, successors, heirs and assigns, do hereby grant and convey to The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, reconstruct, perpetually maintain and operate a buried telephone cable and wire system on said property on a strip of land 10 feet wide along the North ~~and~~ ^{East} property line of said land as said property line now appears or may hereafter appear of record in said county,

together with the right of access to said land for the purposes of repairing, replacing, and maintaining said buried telephone cable and wire system; and shall pay grantor for damage, if any, to fences and growing crops arising from the construction and maintenance of the aforesaid buried telephone system.
