NOTICE AND AWARD OF APPRAISERS

WHEREAS, on the 28th day of July, 1884, the undersigned,  
who were and now are, residents of Sarpy County, Nebraska and freeholders therin,  
were by the County Judge of said County duly appointed appraisers to inspect  
and view the premises hereinafter described, and to assess the amount of damages  
according to the owners thereof and any others having or claiming an interest therein  
by reason of the appropriation thereof to the extent hereinbefore stated by the Chicago  
Burlington & Quincy Railroad Company for all and singular its railroad purposes,  
including right of way, main and side tracks, buildings, switches, water stations,  
turn-outs, offices and structures necessary and convenient to and for the construction,  
repair, maintenance, use and operation of said railroad, the lands and premises and  
interests therein so appropriated being within Sarpy County, Nebraska and hereinafter  
described.

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the appraisers aforesaid, do find that the  
title to the respective tracts of land, real estate and premises is as hereinbefore  
stated. NOW, THEREFORE, we, the undersigned, each being a resident of and  
a disinterested freeholder in Sarpy County, Nebraska, and not interested in a  
like question, having as aforesaid been duly appointed appraisers herein for said  
purposes, and having been duly qualified by each taking the oath prescribed by law,  
did on the 18th day of August, 1884, commencing at the hour of ten o'clock  
in the forenoon, then being the day and hour named in the notice filed in the County  
Court of said county, duly served on the owners of said real estate, both personally  
and in a body, especially before whom the undersigned had publicly read

Beginning at a point on the West line of said Section 12, from which point the South East corner of said Section bears South 0 degrees 08 minutes East a distance of 1200.0 feet; thence South

TRACT NO. 1

A tract of land located in the North half (N½) of the North West Quarter (NW<sup>1</sup>) of Section Twelve (12) T 15 N R 13 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, in the County of Sarpy, State of Nebraska, being described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the West line of said Section 12, from which point the South East corner of said Section bears South 0 degrees 08 minutes East a distance of 1200.0 feet; thence South

0 degrees 08 minutes East a distance of 217.4 feet along the West line of said Section 12; thence northwesterly on a curve to the right having a radius of 1255.00 feet a distance of 379.8 feet to a point on the South line of said Section 12, from which point

the Southwest corner of said Section bears North 00 degrees 41 minutes East a distance of 437.00 feet; thence South 00 degrees 41 minutes East a distance of 944.01 feet along the South line of said Section 12; thence northwesterly on a curve to the right,

having a radius of 1502.00 feet a distance of 1197.8 feet, this course and the following courses each being on lines parallel to and 76 feet distant north-easterly from the centerline of realigned railroad tracks as measured at right angles thereto; thence

an line tangent to last described curve North 36 degrees 07 minutes West a distance of 84.83 feet; thence North 34 degrees 28 minutes West a distance of 69.47 feet; thence northwesterly on a curve to the left having a radius of 1255.00 feet a distance of 480.48

feet to the point of beginning, containing 7.07 acres, more or less.

TRACT NO. 2

A tract of land located in the Southeast Quarter (SE<sup>1</sup>) of the Southwest Quarter (SW<sup>1</sup>) of Section Twelve (12) T 15 N R 13 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, in the County of Sarpy, State of Nebraska, being described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the East line of said Southwest Quarter of Section 12, from which point the Southeast corner of said quarter

section bears South 0 degrees 08 minutes East a distance of 161.5 feet, said point being on the east line of proposed realigned track;

thence North 0 degrees 01 minutes East a distance of 152.75 feet along said East line of the Southwest Quarter; thence South 76

degrees 18 minutes East a distance of 859.76 feet to a point on the South line of said Section 12, this course being 125 feet distant

northwesterly from the centerline of proposed realigned track as measured at right angles thereto; thence North 0 degrees 01 minutes

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and that Herman Platt is the owner of said lands under lease, who appeared by himself.

We find the value of the land described above in Tracts Nos. 1, 2 and 3 as follows:

We find all other damages, including owner's share of present crop on said Tracts Nos. 1, 2 and 3, according to the owner thereof by reason of the appropriation of said land to be the sum of . . . . . \$ 1840.00

We find the tenant's share of present crop on said Tracts Nos. 1, 2 and 3, and all other damages to said tenant, to be the sum of . . . . . \$ 360.00

We hereby accordingly award and assess said value and damages on account of the appropriation of the lands as described in Tracts Nos. 1, 2 and 3 above in the total sum of \$ 5376.70

WE, THEREFORE, do hereby find and assess the interests of the parties herein in the lands, premises and real estate described in Tracts Nos. 1, 2 and 3 above, and the award above made for the appropriation thereof by Chicago, Burlington & Quincy Railroad Company as follows:

#### TRACT NO. 4

A tract of land located in the Southwest Quarter ( $\text{SW}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter ( $\text{SW}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ ) of Section Six (6) of T. 13 N. R. 14 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, in the County of Sarpy, State of Nebraska, being described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the North line of said Southwest Quarter ( $\text{SW}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter ( $\text{SW}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ ) of Section Six (6) a distance of 160 feet East of the West line of said Section 6, said point being on the centerline of proposed relocated track; thence proceeding due South parallel with and 160 feet east of the West line of said Section 6 on centerline of proposed relocated track a distance of 1521.0 feet, with tract of land extending 127 feet westerly to the easterly line of county road and extending 79 feet easterly from said centerline, to the South line of said Southwest Quarter ( $\text{SW}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter ( $\text{SW}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ ) of Section Six (6), containing 6.178 acres, more or less.

A permanent easement for construction, maintenance, and operation of drainage ditch, including pipe lines for outlet into Papillion Creek, over the following land, to wit: A tract of land located in the Northwest quarter ( $\text{NW}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ ) of Section Thirteen (13) T. 15 N. & 15 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, in the County of Sarpy, State of Nebraska, being described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the West line of said Section 13, from which point the Northwest corner of Section 13 bears North 0 degrees 02 minutes East a distance of 1794.6 feet; thence North 35 degrees 25 minutes East a distance of 531.6 feet on a line parallel to and 75 feet distant southeasterly from the center line of railroad relocation as measured at right angles thereto; thence South 51 degrees 35 minutes East a distance of 75 feet; thence South 35 degrees 25 minutes West a distance of 628.3 feet to a point on the West line of said Section 13; thence North 0 degrees 02 minutes East a distance of 140.8 feet to the point of beginning, subject to prior rights of the Papillion Drainage District, containing 1.100 acres, more or less.

We find that the fee simple title to said Tracts Nos. 4, 5, 6 and 7 above described is in Edward S. Foe, who appeared by Herman Platt, and that Vernon M. Foe, his wife, has no title or possession other than her right of inheritance from her husband, and that Lloyd Hardy is the tenant of said premises under lease, who appeared by himself.

We find the value of the land described above in Tracts Nos. 4, 5, 6 and 7 as follows:

Award to Lloyd Hardy, the sum of . . . . . \$ 345.54


For tract numbered 10 and described in said Appraisers' Report:
