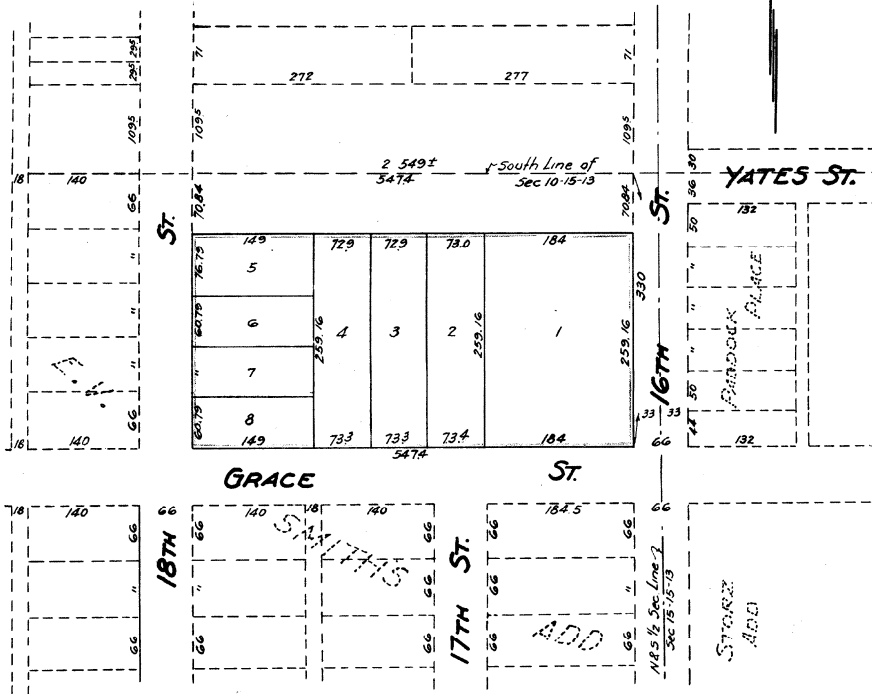


# GERMAN OLD PEOPLE'S HOME ADDITION

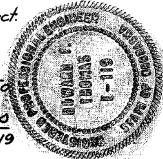

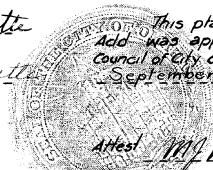
