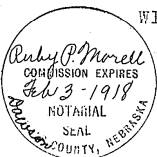

of the sum of One Dollar and other valuable consideration to us

in hand paid by the Elkhorn Valley Drainage District, second part, the receipt of which is
hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said second party, its
successors or assigns, all that certain tract, ^{piece} or parcel of land situate, lying and being in
the county of Douglas, and State of Nebraska, and described as follows: to wit:

A strip or piece of land 4 rods wide, being 2 rods wide on west side, and 2 rods
wide on the east side of the center line of the cut-off ditch, drainage ditch, or levee, each
or all as the case may be, as the same is now surveyed and located by second party, and ex-
tending across from about the center of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15 due south to the south side of of
section Fifteen in township Fifteen range Ten, together with any and all desired access thereto
by said Drainage District, its agents, contractors, representatives and employees, across other
portions of said land of first parties..
