AN ORDINANCE CLOSING A PORTION OF EIGHTH STREET FROM THE SOUTH CURB LINE OF ELM STREET THENCE SOUTH TO THE NORTH PROPERTY LINE OF BURLINGTON NORTHERN RAILROAD, THE SAME BEING A REGULARLY ESTABLISHED AND PLATTED STREET WITHIN THE CITY; TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE IN PAMPHLET FORM; TO PROVIDE FOR A TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEWARD, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. <u>Street Closed</u>. That a portion of Eighth Street from the South Curb line of Elm Street thence South to the North property line of Burlington Northern Railroad as originally platted, be and the same hereby is closed.

Section 2. <u>Public Interest</u>. That it is deemed advantageous and in the public interest, safety, welfare and convenience to close said portion of said street, and that upon said closing, said portion of street shall not be vacated, but ownership of said portion of street shall remain with the City of Seward.

Section 3. Pamphlet form; publication; when operative. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication or posting as provided by law and city ordinance.
