THESE ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 28th day of May A.D. 1912 by and between the Byron Reed Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Nebraska, party of the first part, and Suviah B. Joslin, party of the second part.

Witnesseth. Whereas, party of the first part is the owner of that

certain real estate situate in the County of Douglas and State of Nebraska, known and described as the east one-half (E.2) of Lot Five (5) in Block Two (2) in Capitol Hill Addition to the City of Omaha, and party of the second part is the owner of the west one-half (W.2) of said lot five (5) in Block two (2) in said Capitol Hill Addition, and

Whereas, party of the first part is about to erect a one-story brick building on its property, and it is desired. to establish a party wall between said parties.

Now, it is hereby agreed.

First, that the said wall, thirteen (13) inches in thickness shall be placed one-half thereof on the property of the party of the first part, and one-half thereof on the property of the party of the second part, so that the dividing line between said properties shall be the center line of said brick wall, and hereafter said wall shall be kept and maintained as a party wall.

Second. That party of the second part shall be granted and is hereby granted the privilege of joining any building that she may hereafter erect on her said property to said party wall, when constructed, by paying therefor one-half of the cost of construction of said wall.

Third. Either party may add to said party wall in height, depth, or thickness, and in case of damage may repair, or in case of destruction rebuild said wall and any addition thereto, carrying up flues and the like to leave the other party as near as may be in as good condition as before, and using good materials, and workmanship and conforming to the building laws and ordinances of the City of Omaha and doing work from his own side if the other side is built upon, and in case of repairs made while the wall, or any part thereof, is in use by both parties, one-half the cost of such repairs shall be paid to the party making the same by the owner of the other parcel on demand and one-half the value of such rebuilt wall, or any addition made as accreased to any wall, when used shall be paid for like the original structure.

Fourth. The parties to this agreement mutually covenant for themselves and their respective heirs, successors and assigns, each to and with the other, his heirs, successors and assigns, to observe the above agreement, and that the covenants herein contained shall run with the land but no owner or lessee is to be responsible except for his acts or defaults while owner or lessee.

Fifth. In case of dispute as to any value before mentioned, the amount thereof shall be referred to disinterested parties to be appointed one by each of the then parties to the appraisement and the referees so chosen to choose, in case of disagreement, a third person to act as arbiter, and the arbiters so chosen shall have full power and authority to determine the amount of such values.
