CONSENT TO CUT AND REMOVE TREES

KNOW ALL MEN BY THOSE PRESENTS:

That Mack Hayward and Geneva Hayward his wife, (hereinafter called "Grantor") of Richardson County, Nebraska, are the owners of the following described real estate, to-wit:

The North-east Quarter of the South-west Quarter (NE4 of SW4) of Section Thirty-two (32) Township Three (3) North Range Thirteen (13) East of the Sixth (6th).

situated in Richardson County, Nebraska, and the Consumers Public Power District (hereinafter called "District") is constructing or contemplates constructing a transmission line on the above described property or on property adjacent thereto.

The District desires to cut down and remove all trees and undergrowth which may interfere with the construction, operation, and maintenance of same.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the payment of \$25.00 in hand paid by the District, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Grantor hereby grants unto the District the right to cut down and remove all trees and undergrowth for a distance of Fifty (50) feet on each side of the center line of said transmission line as the same now is or may hereafter be constructed on said property or on property adj cent thereto, providing the work is done at the expense of the District and in the following manner, to-wit:

Cut trees in fourteen foot lengths and pile along right of way. Burn all brush. and, provided further that the District will leave the transmission line right-of-way in good condition and satisfactory to Grantor.

The Grantor further grants unto the District, the perpetual right to cut or remove all trees and undergrowth which may hereafter grow within the above specified distance of said transmission line.
