- 2. This-permit-revises-the-authorization-previously-granted-for-a-pole-sign-shown-on-North-27th-Street-(Use-Permit-42)-to-a-ground-sign-no-more-than-6-ft:-im-height-and-100-sq:-ft:-in-area.
- 3. This sign and all development and construction shall comply with the approved plans.
- 4. The terms, conditions, and requirements of this resolution shall be binding and obligatory upon the Permittee, successors, and assigns. The building official shall report violations to the City Council which may revoke the special permit or take such other action as may be necessary to gain compliance.
- 5. The Permittee shall sign and return the City's letter of acceptance to the City Clerk within 30 days following approval of the special permit, provided, however, said 30-day period may be extended up to six months by administrative amendment. The City Clerk shall file a copy of the resolution approving the special permit and the letter of acceptance with the Register of Deeds, filing fees therefor to be paid in advance by the Permittee.
