ORDINANCE NO. 74-2
AN ORDINANCE CREATING CERTAIN STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICTS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF CLATONIA, GAGE COUNTY, NEBRASKA, TO BE KNOWN AS STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NOS. 4 AND 5; DEFINING THE BOUNDARIES AND PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF CERTAIN STREETS BY GRADING, GUTTERING, CURBING, SURFACING, SUBSURFACE STRUCTURES AND APPURTENANCES AND SUCH OTHER WORK AS MAY BE INCIDENTAL THERETO.

Section 1. There is hereby created within the Village of Clatonia, Nebraska, a street improvement district to be known and designated as Street Improvement District No. 4, the outer boundaries of which are as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the centerline of Jefferson Street, as platted in the Village of Clatonia, Nebraska, and the west corporate limit line, said corporate limit line being the west line of Section 22, Township 8 North, Range 5 East, Gage County, Nebraska; thence in a southerly direction along the west line of said Section 22, a distance of one hundred eighty (180) feet; thence in an easterly direction along a line parallel to and one hundred eighty (180) feet southerly from the centerline of Jefferson Street, as platted in the Village of Clatonia, Nebraska, to a point one hundred eighty (180) feet westerly from the centerline of Walnut Street, as platted in the Village of Clatonia, Nebraska; then in a southerly direction along a line parallel to and one hundred eighty (180) feet westerly from the centerline of said Walnut Street, to a point on the north line of Adams Street, as platted in the Village of Clatonia, said point being one hundred eighty (180) feet westerly from the centerline of said Walnut Street; thence in an easterly direction along the north line of said Adams Street, to a point one hundred eighty (180) feet easterly from the centerline of said Walnut Street; thence in a northerly direction along a line parallel to and one hundred eighty (180) feet southerly from the centerline of said Jefferson Street, to a point one hundred eighty (180) feet westerly from the centerline of Cottonwood Street, as platted in the Village of Clatonia, Nebraska; thence in a southerly direction along a line parallel to and one hundred eighty (180) feet westerly from the centerline of said Cottonwood Street, to a point on the north line of Adams Street, said point being one hundred eighty (180) feet westerly from the centerline of said Cottonwood Street; thence in an easterly direction along the north line of said Adams Street, to a point one hundred eighty (180) feet easterly from the centerline of said Cottonwood Street; thence in a northerly direction along a line parallel to and one hundred eighty (180) feet easterly from the centerline of said Cottonwood Street, to a point one hundred eighty (180) feet northerly from the centerline of said Jefferson Street; thence in a westerly direction along a line parallel to and one hundred eighty (180) feet northerly from the centerline of said Jefferson Street, to a point on the east line of Oak Street, as platted in the Village of Clatonia, Nebraska, said point being one hundred eighty (180) feet northerly from the centerline of said Jefferson Street; thence in a northerly direction along the east line of said Oak Street, to a point one hundred eighty (180) feet northerly from the centerline of said Jefferson Street; thence in a westerly direction along a line parallel to and one hundred eighty (180) feet northerly from the centerline of said Jefferson Street, to a point on the west corporate limit line, a distance of one hundred eighty (180) feet to the point of beginning.

The following streets within said Street Improvement District shall be and are hereby ordered improved by grading, guttering, curbing, surfacing, subsurface structures and appurtenances and such other work as may be incidental thereto: Jefferson Street from the west corporate limit line of Clatonia, Nebraska, to the east line of Cottonwood Street; and a portion of Cottonwood Street from the north line of Jefferson Street to the north line of Adams Street; and a portion of Lincoln Street from the east line of Locust Street to the east line of Oak Street; and a portion of Walnut Street from the north line of Lincoln Street to the north line of Adams Street; including the intersections on all streets, all being located within the corporate limits of the Village of Clatonia, Gage County, Nebraska.

Section 2. There is hereby created within the Village of Clatonia, Nebraska, a street improvement district to be known and designated as Street Improvement District No. 5, the outer boundaries of which are as follows: Beginning at the point of intersection of the centerline of Oak Street, as platted in the Village of Clatonia, Nebraska, and the south line of Washington Street, as platted in the Village of Clatonia, Nebraska; thence in an easterly direction along the south line of said Washington Street, a distance of one hundred eighty (180) feet; thence in a southerly direction along a line parallel to and one hundred eighty (180) feet easterly from the centerline of said Oak Street, to a point 140 feet south of the south line of Jay Street, as platted in the Village of Clatonia, Nebraska, said point being one hundred eighty (180) feet easterly from the centerline of said Oak Street; thence in a westerly direction along a line parallel to and 140 feet southerly from the south line of said Jay Street, a distance of three hundred sixty (360) feet; thence in a northerly direction along a line parallel to and one hundred eighty (180) feet westerly from the centerline of said Oak Street, to a point on the south line of said Washington Street, said point being one hundred eighty (180) feet westerly from the centerline of said Oak Street; thence in an easterly direction along the south line of said Washington Street, a distance of one hundred eighty (180) feet to the point of beginning.

The following streets within said Street Improvement District shall be and are hereby ordered improved by grading, guttering, curbing, surfacing, subsurface structures and appurtenances and such other work as may be incidental thereto; Oak Street from the south line of Washington Street to 140 feet south of the south line of Jay Street including the intersections on all streets, all being located in the corporate limits of the Village of Clatonia, Gage County, Nebraska.

Section 3. All of said improvements shall be constructed to the established grades as fixed by Ordinance of said Village and shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications to be made by Consulting Engineers employed by the Village, to be approved by the Board, said improvements shall be made at public cost but special assessments on the specially benefited property may be levied to reimburse the Village to the extent provided by law.

Section 4. Notice of the creation of said District shall be published in The Beatrice Daily Sun, a legal newspaper of general circulation in said Village for two weeks after the publication of this Ordinance. If any of the sections, Nos. 1 through 4, of this Ordinance, is voided for any reason, all other sections of this Ordinance shall be valid as long as any section shall exist.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be PASSED and APPROVED this 15th day of March, 1974. Charles W. Schuerman, Chairman
