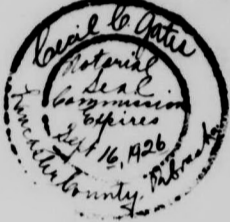

ORDINANCE NO. 412

An ordinance to vacate the alleys located in and through blocks numbers 106 and 126, Original Plat of the City of University Place, Nebraska, and block number 3, Mount Forrest Addition to the City of University Place, Nebraska, subject to certain easement rights therein.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PLACE, NEBRASKA:

Sec. 1. That the alley as now located in and through block no. 106 of the Original Plat of the City of University Place, be and the same is hereby vacated and closed as a public thoroughfare.

Sec. 2. That the alley as now located in and through block No. 126 of the Original Plat of the City of

University Place, be and the same hereby is vacated and closed as a public thoroughfare.

Sec. 3. That the alley as now located in and through block No. 3, Mount Forrest Addition to the City of University Place, be and the same hereby is vacated and closed as a public thoroughfare.

Sec. 4. Such vacating is subject however to the right of the City of University Place to a perpetual easement in said alleys and each of them for the purpose of going therein at all times to construct, repair or replace sewer or water pipes or mains therein and to construct, erect and maintain electric wires in underground conduits or supported overhead by poles in, upon and through the said alleys and each of them, and for the purpose of constructing and maintaining in the space now platted as such alleys, any other municipal utility proper to be constructed and maintained in and through the alleys of said city.

Sec. 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Sec. 6. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
