ORDINANCE NO. 2332

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HASTINGS, ADAMS COUNTY, NEBRASKA,
TO VACATE A REGULARLY ESTABLISHED AND PLATTED STREET WITHIN SAID
CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
HASTINGS, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. That a portion of east "B" Street more particularly
described as follows:

Commencing One Hundred Fifty (150') Feet East
of the Northwest corner, Lot Twelve (12),
Block Two (2), Spencer Brothers Park Addition
to the City of Hastings, as a point of begin-
ning, thence East Five Hundred Ten (510') Feet
to the Northeast corner of Lot One (1), Block
One (1), Spencer Brothers Park Addition, thence
North Seventy (70') Feet, thence West Five
Hundred Ten (510') Feet, thence South Seventy
(70') Feet to the point of beginning, all in
the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest
Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Seventeen (17),
Township Seven (7) North, Range Nine (9),
West of the 6th P.M., Adams County, Nebraska,

as originally platted, be and hereby is vacated and closed in
accordance with the laws of the State of Nebraska in connection
with the vacating and closing of streets and the City Clerk is
hereby authorized and empowered, and directed to certify the same
to the Register of Deeds of Adams County, Nebraska, and to designate
upon the official map of the City of Hastings the closing thereof.

SECTION 2. That it is deemed advantageous and for the best
interest of said city to vacate said street and upon such vacation
said street shall be and remain the property of the city but may
be sold and conveyed by the city.

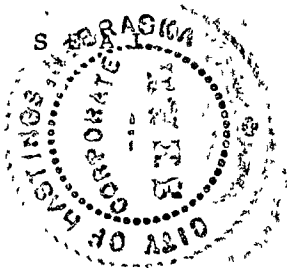
SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force from
