Affiant further deposes and says that the boundaries of the above mentioned Natural Resources District(s) were officially established by the Nebraska Soil and Water Conservation Commission on September 14, 1971, pursuant to section 2-3203 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and that pursuant to section 2-3206(1) Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, each above mentioned Natural Resources District did by operation of law assume at 12:01 a.m., July 1, 1972, all the rights, titles and interests in any real estate lying within its boundaries which belonged to said Turtle Creek Watershed Conservancy District and which is located in the County of Sarpy

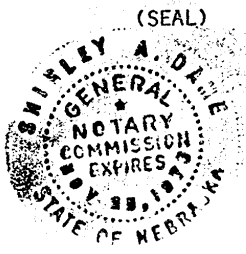
