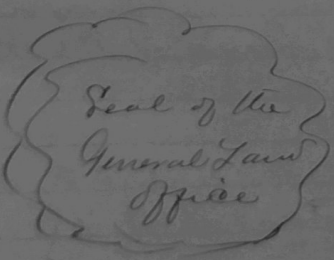

Examined To all to whom these presents shall come Greeting  
Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the General Land Office at Lincoln Nebraska whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20<sup>th</sup> May 1862 "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain" and the acts supplemental thereto the claim of Cornelius West has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the South half of the South East quarter and the North East quarter of the South East quarter of Section Twenty five in Township Nine North of Range Two East and the South West quarter of the South West quarter of Section Thirty in Township Nine North of Range Three East in the District of Lands Subject to Sale at Lincoln Nebraska containing one hundred and fifty nine acres and sixty four hundredths of an acre according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General

Now Know ye That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Cornelius West the tract of land above described To Have and To Hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances thereof unto the said Cornelius West and to his heirs and assigns forever

In Testimony Whereof J. Volysed S. Grant President of the United States of the America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed

Given under my hand at the City of Washington the first day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty nine and of the Independence of the United States the ninety fourth
