SPECIAL PERMIT NO. 1437A

WHEREAS, General Excavating, has submitted an application designated as Special Permit No. 1437A for authority to extend the termination date of Special Permit 1437 which authorized the extraction of 60,000 cubic yards of soil on property located Southwest of North 27th Street and I-80, and legally described to wit:

Lot 19 I.T., Section 36, Township 11 North, Range 6 East of the 6th P.M., Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln City-Lancaster County Planning Commission has held a public hearing on said application; and

WHEREAS, the community as a whole, the surrounding neighborhood, and the real property adjacent to the area included within the plot plan for this will not be adversely affected by granting such a permit; and

WHEREAS, said plot plan together with the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth are consistent with the comprehensive plan of the City of Lincoln and with the intent and purpose of Title 27 of the Lincoln Municipal Code to promote the public health, safety, morals, and general welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lincoln City-Lancaster County Planning Commission of Lincoln, Nebraska:

That the application of General Excavating, hereinafter referred to as "Permittee", to extend the termination date of Special Permit No. 1437 be and the same is hereby granted under the provisions of Section 27.63.160 of the Lincoln Municipal Code upon condition that continued excavation of said soil shall be in strict compliance with said application, the plot plan, and

 the following additional express terms, conditions, and requirements:

- 1. This permit approves an extension of Special Permit No. 1437 for an additional 120 days from the date of approval for the extraction of soil to the new topography as shown on the site plan. All other conditions of Special Permit No. 1437 shall remain in effect.
- 2. This permit shall remain in effect for 120-days from the date of this resolution's approval and all required work shall be completed within the 120-day extension.
- 3. Excavation and final topography shall comply with the approved plans.
- 4. The terms, conditions, and requirements of this resolution shall be binding and obligatory upon the Permittee and the Permittee's successors and assigns. The building official shall report violations to the City Council which may revoke the special permit or take such other action as may be necessary to gain compliance.
- 5. The Permittee shall sign and return the City's letter of acceptance to the City Clerk within 30 days following approval of the special permit, provided, however, said 30-day period may be extended up to six months by administrative amendment. The City Clerk shall file a copy of the resolution approving the special permit and the letter of acceptance with the Register of Deeds, filing fees therefor to be paid in advance by the Permittee.
