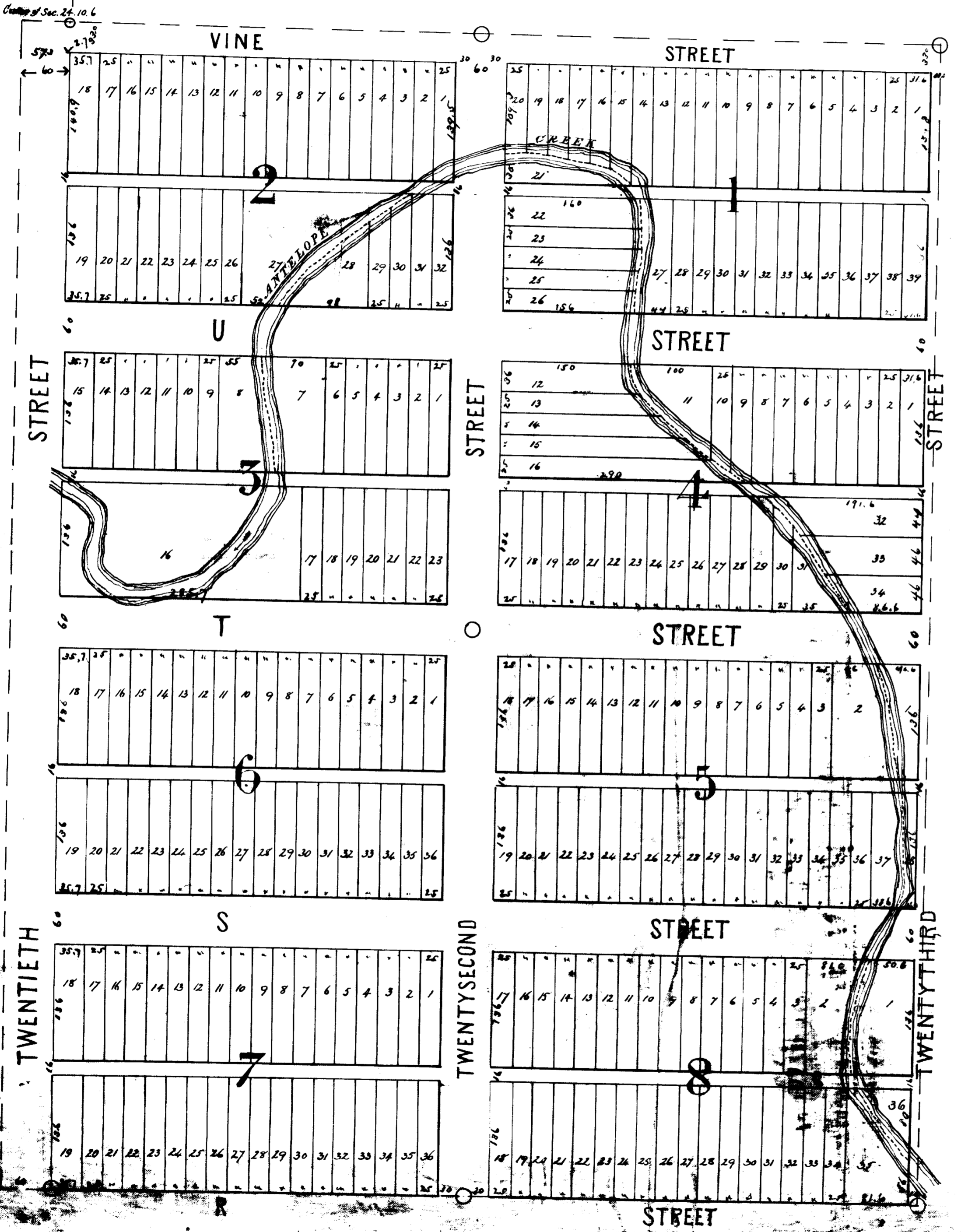

LEGEND.
 Thereby certify that I have accurately surveyed and staked off into lots, block streets and alleys Lincoln Driving Park Company's subdivision as shown on the annexed plat and described in the statement attached. All lots have dimensions as indicated in feet and decimals by red figures on the plat. Vine Street is 33 feet wide S. T. U and 22nd Street are each 60 feet wide. 23rd Street is 10 feet wide off this tract. All alleys are 16 feet wide. Lots 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, and 27 in Block 1; Lots 27, 28, 29, and 30 in Block 2; Lots 7 and 8 in Block 3; Lots 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, and 34 in Block 4; Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, and 27 in Block 5 have a boundary in the center of Antelope Creek as shown by dotted line on the plat. All lines except the Creek boundaries and the South Line of Vine Street are parallel with or at right angles to the North Line of R. Street. Oak stakes are set at all lot corners on the block lines except in the Creek.
