Whereas there has been deposited in the general Land office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of Land office at Beatrice Nebraska. whereby it appears that pursuant to the act of Congress approved 28th May 1862 "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain" and the acts supplemental thereto the claim of John M^cFarren has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the South half of the South west quarter of Section Thirty four in Township six North of Range Three East in the district of lands subject to sale at Beatrice Nebraska containing eighty acres according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General John Knowlton that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said John M^cFarren the tract of land above described To have and to hold the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereto unto the said John M^cFarren and to his heirs and assigns forever In Testimony Whereof I Rutherford B. Hayes President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the seal of the General Land office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the twentieth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy seven and of the Independence of the United States the One hundred and first.
