# RESOLUTION NO. A- 81591

### SPECIAL PERMIT NO. 1930

WHEREAS, Thompson Creek L.L.C. as submitted an application designated as Special Permit No. 1930 for authority to develop Thompson Creek Community Unit Plan for approximately 352 dwelling units and waivers of the required lot area for single family dwellings, lot width requirements, to allow multiple family dwellings with a height of 40 feet, and to waive the front, side and rear setbacks, on property located east of South 56th Street and Union Hill Road, and legally described to wit:

> A portion of Lot 35 Irregular Tract in the South Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 21, Township 9 North, Range 7 East of the 6th P.M., Lancaster County, Nebraska, and more fully described by metes and bounds as follows:

Referring to the southwest corner of said South Half of the Northwest Quarter; thence north 89 degrees 58 minutes 01 second east (an assumed bearing) on the south line of said South Half, a distance of 50.00 feet to a point on the east rightof-way line of South 56th Street and the point of beginning; thence north 00 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds west on said line, a distance of 517.32 feet; thence south 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds east, a distance of 160.42 feet; thence south 00 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds west, a distance of 17.50 feet; thence south 89 degrees 59 minutes 59 seconds east, a distance of 62.43 feet to the point of curvature of a curve to the right, having a central angle of 19 degrees 47 minutes 51 seconds, a radius of 323.00 feet, an arc length of 111.61 feet, a chord length of 111.05 feet and a chord bearing south 80 degrees 06 minutes 04 seconds east; thence on said curve, a distance of 111.61 feet to the point of tangency; thence north 25 degrees 05 minutes 42 seconds east, a distance of 307.59 feet; thence north 15 degrees 12 minutes 17 seconds east, a distance of 145.62 feet to the point of curvature of a curve to the left, having a central angle of 15 degrees 13 minutes 43 seconds, a radius of 564.00 feet, an

WHEREAS, said site plan together with the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth are consistent with the intent and purpose of Title 27 of the Lincoln Municipal Code to promote the public health, safety, and general welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

That the application of Thompson Creek L.L.C., hereinafter referred to as "Permittee", to develop Thompson Creek Community Unit Plan, on the property legally described above, be and the same is hereby granted under the provisions of Section 27.63.320 and Chapter 27.65 of the Lincoln Municipal Code upon condition that

- 10. The terms, conditions, and requirements of this resolution shall be binding and obligatory upon the Permittee, successors, and assigns. The building official shall report violations to the City Council which may revoke the special permit or take such other action as may be necessary to gain compliance.
- 11. The Permittee shall sign and return the City's letter of acceptance to the City Clerk within 30 days following approval of the special permit, provided, however, said 30-day period may be extended up to six months by administrative amendment. The City Clerk shall file a copy of the resolution approving the special permit and the letter of acceptance with the Register of Deeds, filing fees therefor to be paid in advance by the Permittee.
