### USE PERMIT NO. 141

WHEREAS, Thompson Creek, L.L.C. has submitted an application in accordance with Section 27.27.080 of the Lincoln Municipal Code designated as Use Permit No. 141 for authority to construct 114,500 sq. ft. of office space which includes 37,000 square feet of live-work office space and 16 dwelling units, with waivers of the required setbacks, a reduction of the required parking, and a reduction of the required open space for dwellings, on property generally located east of South 56th Street and Union Hill Road, and legally described to wit:

The building official shall report violations to the City Council which may revoke this use permit or take such other action as may be necessary to gain compliance.
