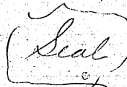

Know all men by these presents that we the Union Pacific Rail Road Company being the original owner and proprietor of the town of Platte Valley in the County of Douglas and State of Nebraska having heretofore caused the same to be surveyed laid out and platted by subdividing the tract whereon said town is located into Blocks Lots Streets Alleys Public Squares and grounds duly staked marked numbered and named; and having heretofore wit. on the Thirty first day of January A. D. 1867 caused and procured the said plat of said town as aforesaid to be duly filed for record and recorded in the Clerk's Office of the County of Douglas State of Nebraska in Book 14 of Deeds on page 300 thereof and for the purpose of vacating a part of said town plat and having caused a true and correct map of such part of said town plat to be made and attached hereto and all of the lots in said part of said town plat being at the date of this instrument the property of said Company free and divested of any claim or title in any other person, do hereby state declare and make known that said part of said town of Platte Valley and all of that part above described and identified is hereby as a town plat fully and completely vacated.

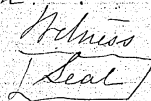
