P.C. LARSEN'S ADD.
FRIEND^{TO}, NEBR.

Being a survey of a part of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec 23 J & H R.R.

Description:— From stone set by A B Smith in Original Town of Friend in Center of Pine Street on North line of Fourth Street I ran south on center of Pine Street until I reached center of First Street. Turning 90° R I ran West to Section line.

Returning to center of 1st and Pine Streets I continued south one block to center of A Street N; thence west to Section line.

With these two lines I established the West line of Cedar Street 400' from center of Pine Street and in a portion of the rectangle described by 1st St. Cedar St and Sec line between Sec 22 and 23 I laid out P.C. Larsen's Addition to Friend Nebr, consisting of 30 lots.

Lots 1-9 and 12-20 are regular - 140' deep and 50' wide. 2nd

Lots 21-29 are regular - 150' deep and 50' wide.

Lots 10-11 and 30 are irregular on the west because location of
the corner cannot be accurately determined. Deeds for these lots should
run, more or less or else west from their east line to a line 33 feet
from the section line.


Points a, b, c, d are marked by 1" iron fingers

Know all men by these Presents:

That I, P. L. Larsen, am seized in fee simple of the following described real estate, to-wit: commencing at a point five hundred sixty two and one half feet north of the southwest corner of the south west quarter of the northwest quarter of section numbered twenty three in township numbered eight, north of range numbered one east of sixth principal meridian in Saline County State of Nebraska, thence running east five hundred fifty three and one half feet more or less to the west line of Cedar Street in Friend Nebraska, thence running north along the west line of Cedar Street a distance of six hundred fifty seven and one half feet more or less to the south line of First Street in Friend, Nebraska, thence west along the south line of First Street five hundred fifty three and one half feet more or less to section line, thence running south six hundred fifty seven and one half feet more or less to the place of beginning, a part of which said premises have been duly platted, as P. L. Larsen's Addition to the city of Friend, in accordance with my wish and desire, said plat having been made by L. B. Perry, Deputy County Surveyor of Saline County State of Nebraska under date of July 20, 1905, and which plat is now lodged in the office of the register of Deeds of said County for record, as required by law, said addition consisting of 30 lots numbered from one to thirty consecutively, together with streets and alleys, all as shown by said plat.

Now therefore, in consideration of the benefits to be therefrom derived from the platting of said premises into said Addition as above set forth we, P. L. Larsen and Amalea Larsen, husband and wife do hereby dedicate and grant unto the public the streets and alleys in P. L. Larsen's Addition to the city of Friend, County of Saline and State of Nebraska, as designated and shown on said plat, the said Amalea Larsen hereby releasing and relinquishing all her right of dowers, in and to said streets and alleys.
