Know all Men by these Presents:

That Charles C. Quiggle and Ida S. Quiggle  
husband and wife  
of the County of Lancaster, and State of Nebraska, for and in consideration  
of the sum of Seven Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty-two (\$7252.00) DOLLARS  
in hand paid, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto Lincoln No. 147  
National Order of Eagles, subordinate series of the Grand Lodge of the  
of the County of Lancaster, and State of Nebraska, the following described  
real estate situated in Lincoln, in Lancaster County, and  
State of Nebraska, to-wit:

The south fifty (50) feet of Lot Four (4), Five (5) and  
Six (6) in Block Thirty-seven (37) of the original plat of the  
City of Lincoln, in said County and State.

This conveyance is made subject to taxes assessed and levied  
for the year 1912, and subsequent thereto.  
Grantors reserve the right to cross said premises with all necessary pipes for heating,  
sewer, or water to supply the north portion of the lots above described.  
Grantors further covenant with the grantee that no building shall be constructed on the north  
portion of the lots above described closer than four feet from the north line of the premises  
herein conveyed.
