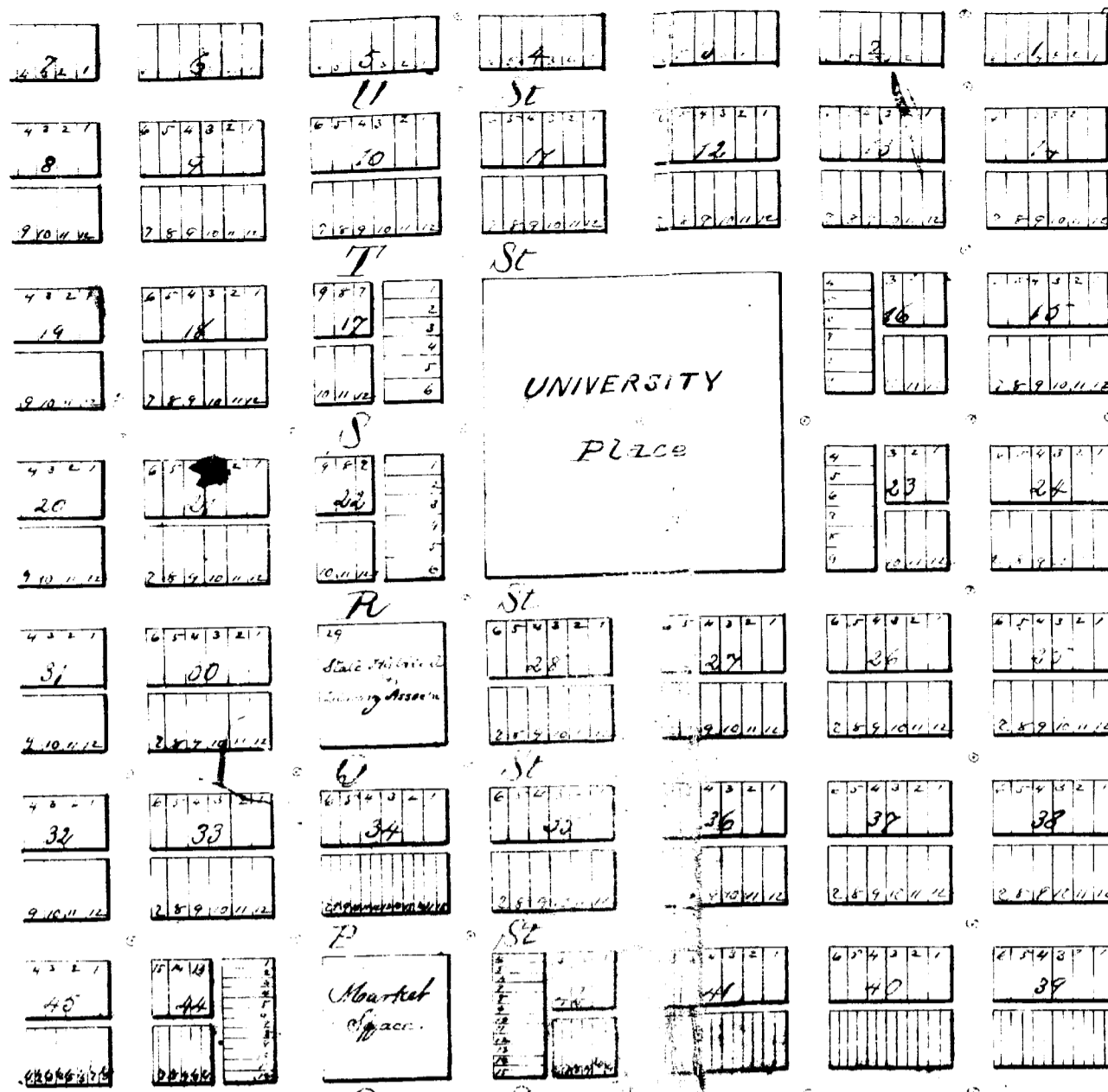


# A Plat of LINCOLN, the CAPITAL of NEBRASKA.

The lots in this plat are numbered in accordance with the following system: The lots in the University Place block are numbered from 1 to 100, beginning with 1 in the northwest corner and increasing in order by rows and then by columns. The lots in the State House Square block are numbered from 101 to 200, beginning with 101 in the northwest corner and increasing in order by rows and then by columns. The lots in the Lincoln Park block are numbered from 201 to 300, beginning with 201 in the northwest corner and increasing in order by rows and then by columns. The lots in the common school block are numbered from 301 to 400, beginning with 301 in the northwest corner and increasing in order by rows and then by columns. The lots in the common school block are numbered from 401 to 500, beginning with 401 in the northwest corner and increasing in order by rows and then by columns. The lots in the common school block are numbered from 501 to 600, beginning with 501 in the northwest corner and increasing in order by rows and then by columns. The lots in the common school block are numbered from 601 to 700, beginning with 601 in the northwest corner and increasing in order by rows and then by columns.
