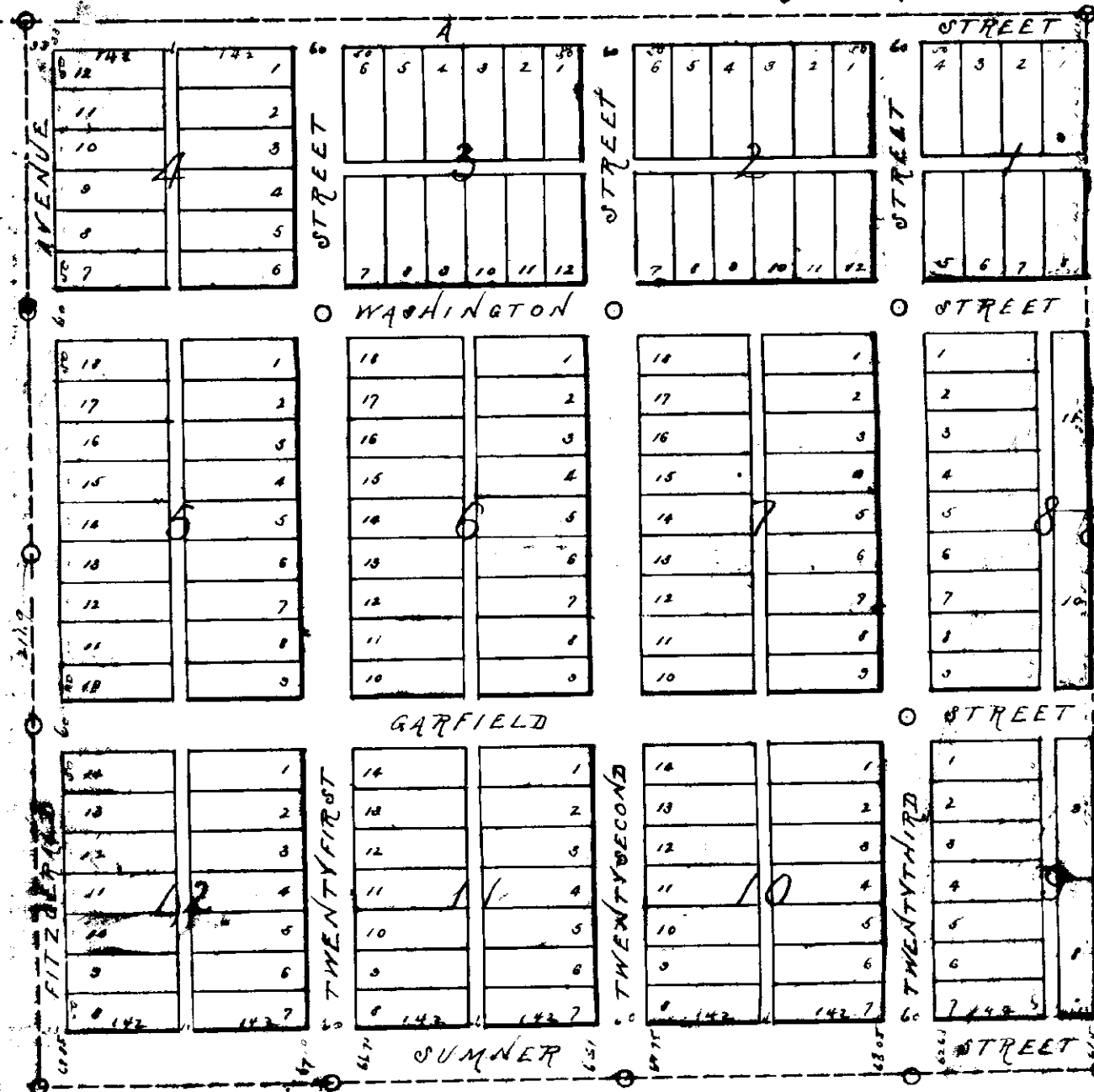
PLEASANT HILL

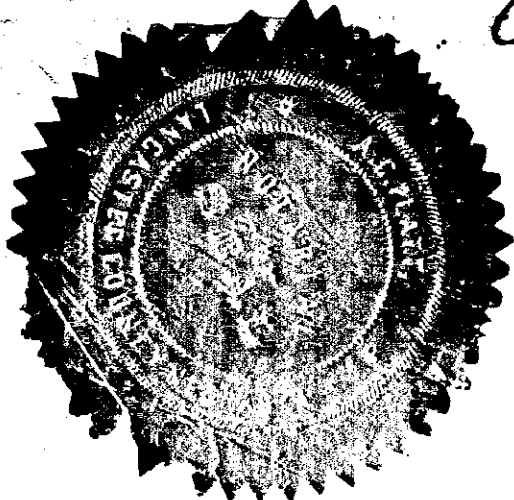
LEGEND

PLEASANT HILL SUBDIVISION comprises the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 36 T. 10. N. 7. E. of the 6th P. M. in Lancaster Co. Neb. otherwise known as lots 3, 4, 5 & 6 in the NE 1/4 of said section 36. All streets and alleys are parallel with, or at right angles to the West line of said NE 1/4. All streets are 60 feet wide, except 1st Street, Summer Street and Fitzgerald Avenue, which have dimensions as marked on the plat. All alleys are 16 feet wide. All lots are 60 feet by 102 feet, except the fractional lots on the East boundary which have dimensions as indicated on the plat. Oak stakes are driven at all lot corners on the block lines. Stones are set at the points marked thereon. Measurements were made with a steel tape.

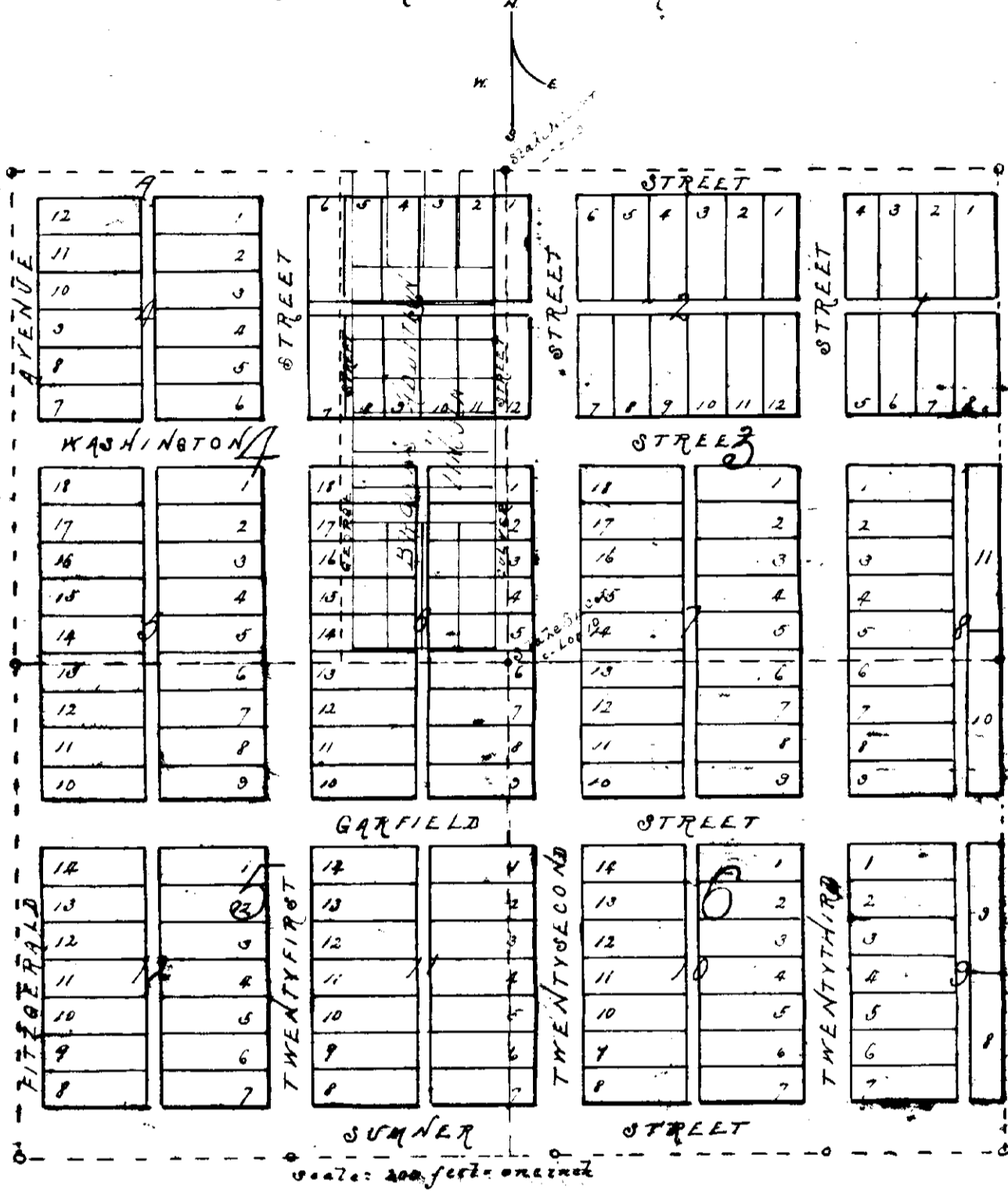

BROWN'S ADDITION TO LINCOLN comprises the East one third (1/3) of Lot 4 in the NE 1/4 of Section 36 T. 10 N. R. 6 E. of the 6th P.M. LANCASTER Co. NEB. Culver Street on the East side and George Street on the West side at each 15 ft. wide.

A strip on the South side is 15 ft. wide. Four lots fronting North are each 48 x 29 feet. South " " 48 x 170 " Seven " East & West " 49 x 192 "

Lots No. 3, 4, 5 & 6 in the NE 1/4 of Section 36 T. 10 N. R. 6 E. are indicated with blue lines and figures on the plat.
