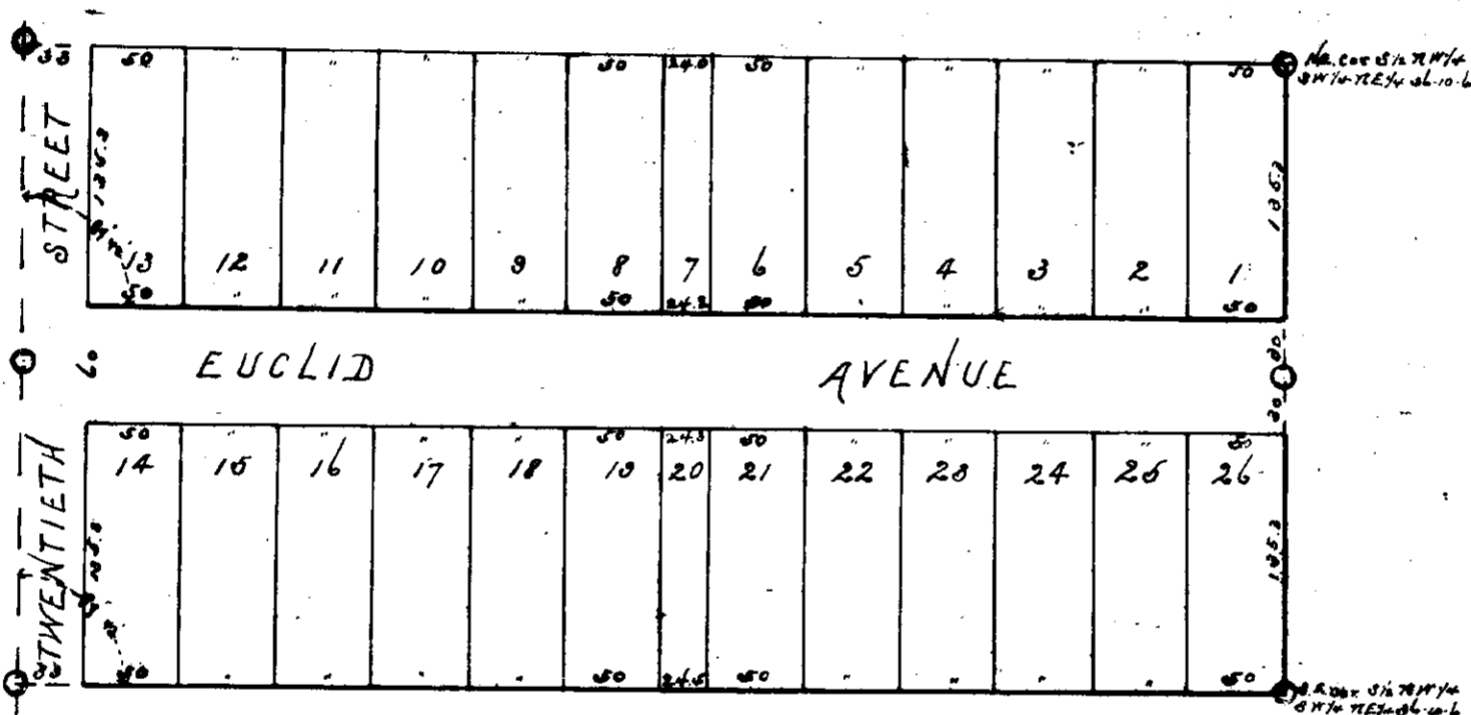
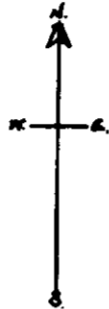


KIND OF INSTRUMENT LOYS BOOK PAGE REMARKS
