Article I of the Amended Articles Of Incorporation its amended to read as follows:

The name of the corporation shall be "German-American Society".

2.

Article V of the Amended Articles Of Incorporation is amended to read as follows:

The affairs of the Society shall be controlled by a Board Of Trustees consisting of at least three (3), and not more than seven (7) Trustees to be elected from the members at their Annual Meeting of Members, together with the Officers who shall be elected by the Members and who automatically become Trustees by virtue thereof. At the first Annual Meeting following the adoption of these amendments, one Trustee shall be elected to serve until the third Annual Meeting, one Trustee shall be elected to serve until the first Annual Meeting, after which, at succeeding elections, all Trustees shall be elected for three year terms. A quorum of the Board Of Trustees for the transaction of business shall consist of not less than one-half (½) of the duly elected Trustees, or more.

3.

Article VI of the Amended Articles Of Incorporation is amended to read as follows:

The Officers of the Society shall be elected by the Members at their first Annual Meeting each year and they shall automatically become members of the Board Of Trustees, and shall consist of the following: President, Secretary, Financial Secretary, Treasurer and Libr ian. All such Officers shall hold office for one (1) year, or until such time as their successors are elected and qualified.

4.

Article VII of the Amended Articles of Incorporation is amended to read as follows:

Amy American citizen of good moral character interested in the objects and purposes of this Society may become a Member thereof as provided for uncor the

conditions set out in the Constitution and By-Laws, but no Member shall be entitled to any profit or distribution of capital earnings of said corporation, but all profits and increases shall be retained by the Society for the benefit and use of said Society for the purposes thereof.

Article VIII of the Amended Articles Of Incorporation is amended to read as follows:

This corporation shall have no capital stock and pay no dividends. Any income shall be expended under the direction of the Board of Directors, in carrying out and promoting the objects and purposes of the Society and this corporation shall not become indebted for more money than is in the Treasury.

Article IX of the Amended Articles Of Incorporation is amended to read as follows:

This corporation shall begin its existence on the 4th day of May 1908 and shall end its existence on the 4th day of May 2008, unless the life of this corporation shall be extended as provided herein or unless sooner dissolved by a vote of its members.

7.

The Amended Articles Of Incorporation are amended by adding Article X, reading as follows:

This society shall not be dissolved until there are eleven members in good standing and in the event of dissolution all real, personal property and other assets shall be endowened to the German Old Peoples Home located at 1702 Grace Street, Chaha, Nebraska, or to its legal successors.

8.

The Amended Articles Of Incorporation are amended by adding Article XI, reading as follows:

Section 1. Amendments to this Constitution may be proposed by any member at any meeting of the Board of Directors The Board may call a special meeting for the purpose of considering such Amendment. The Secretary shall notify all members of such meeting and enclose a copy of such proposed amendment or amendments. Such notice shall be mailed at least ten days before the meeting at which the Amendment is to be considered.

Section 2. If any amendment is approved by more than two-thirds of the members present at any meeting, it shall become effective.
