KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, K. C. Barton and Frank

E. Clark, Trustees under the will of Guy C. Barton, deceased, of the County of Douglas and State of Nebraska, first parties, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Twenty-six and NO/100 Dollars to us in hand paid by Papillion Drainage District, second party, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said second party, its successors or assigns, all that certain tract, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the County of Sarpy and State of Nebraska, and described as follows, to wit:

A strip or piece of land two hundred feet wide, being 100 feet wide on each side of the center line of the cutt-off ditch, drainage ditch, or levee, each or all, as the case may be, as the same is now surveyed and located by second party and extending across from the west side to the east side of the North-east quarter of section thirty-three, township fourteen, Range thirteen, and from the west side to the south side of the south-west quarter of north-west quarter of section thirty-four, township fourteen, range thirteen, otherwise described as commencing at the south-west corner of north-west quarter of North-east quarter of said section, 33; thence to east on center line of NE 1/4 of said section 753 feet, thence on a 3 degree curve to the right 1250 feet, thence on a tangent 1754 feet to the east and west center line of said section thirty-four, together with any and all desired access thereto by said Drainage District, its agents, contractors, representatives and employees across other portions of said land of first parties.
