An ordinance to extend the boundaries and include within the comporate limits of, and to annex to, the City of Beatrice, Nebraska, parts of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) and Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of Section Twenty-One (21), Township Four (4) North, Range Six (6), East of the 6th P.M., and parts of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) and Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of Section Sixteen (16), Township Four (4) North, Range Six (6), East of the 6th P.M., all in Gage County, Nebraska; to provide service benefits thereto; to provide for severability; to confirm zoning classifications; to repeal conflicting ordinances; and to provide for an effective date of this ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEATRICE, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. It is hereby found and determined by the Mayor and City Council that:

- (a) The tracts of land and streets and highways consisting of parts of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) and Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of Section Twenty-one (21), Township Four (4) North, Range Six (6), East of the 6th P.M. and part of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) and Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of Section Sixteen (16), Township Four (4) North, Range Six (6), East of the 6th P.M., all in Gage County, Nebraska, as hereinafter more particularly described, are urban and suburban in character and contiguous and adjacent to the corporate limits of said City;
- (b) Police, Fire, and snow removal benefits will be immediately available thereto, and City water service will be available as provided by law;

- (c) The zoning classification of such tracts of land as shown on the official zoning map of the City of Beatrice, Nebraska, is hereby confirmed;
- (d) There is a unity of interest in the use of such tracts of land and streets and highways with the use of lots, land, streets, and highways in the City, and the community convenience and welfare and the interest of said City will be enhanced through incorporating such tracts of land and streets and highways within the corporate limits of said City.

Section 6. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or the annexation of any tracts of land, streets or highways by this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance, nor affect the validity of the annexations of other tracts of land, streets, or highways by this ordinance, since it is the express intent of the Mayor and City Council to enact each section, subsection, clause or

phrase separately and to annex each tract of land separately.

Section 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 8. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.


