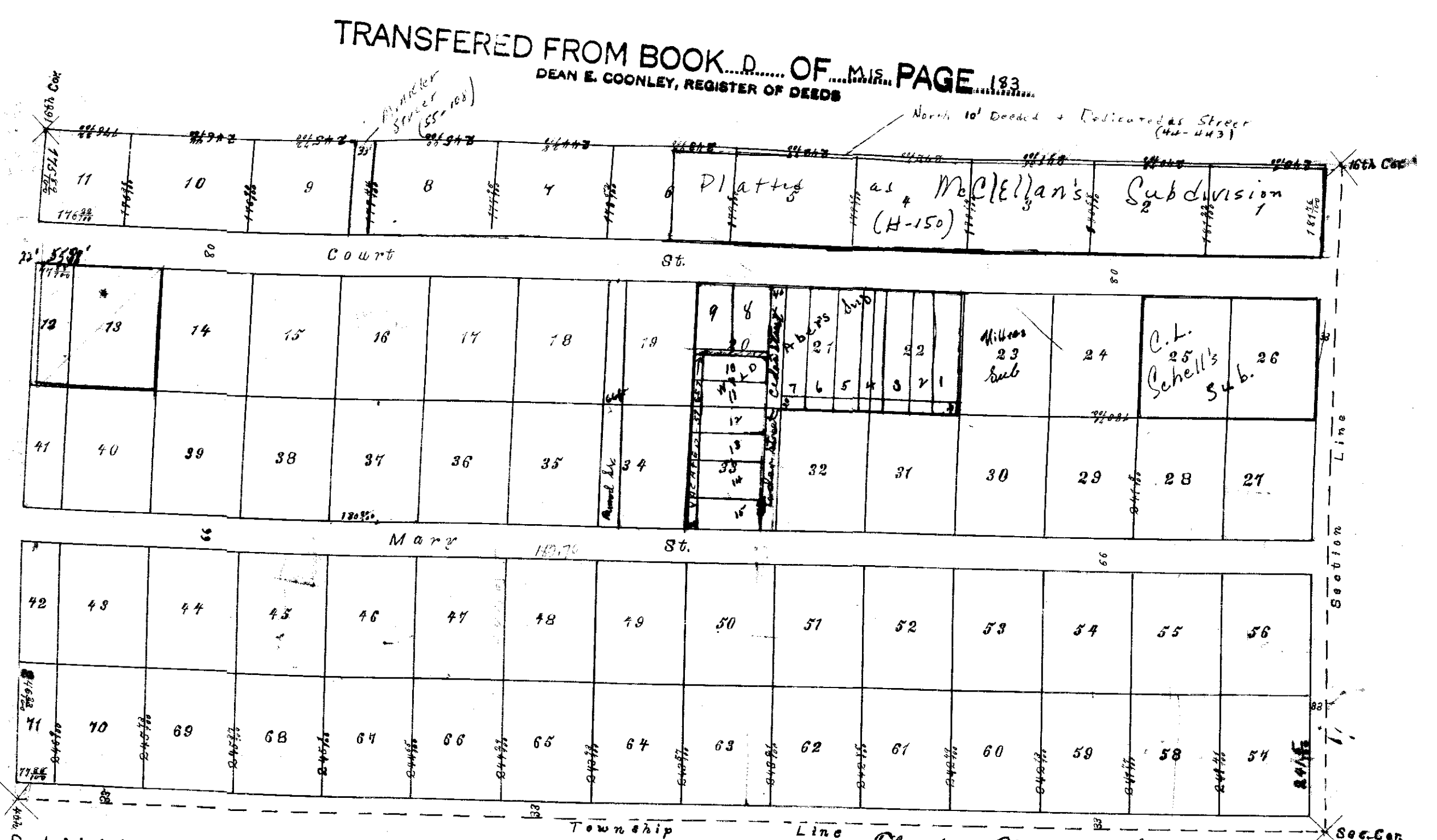

**I.N. McCONNELL'S**  
Sub-division of the south 1/2 of the  
south-east 1/4 of Sec. 32, Township N4 North,  
of Range No. 6 East of the 6th R.M., Gage Co., Neb.

The above is a correct plat of this subdivision as surveyed  
by me from 23rd and 24th 1880. All north-south lines  
of this subdivision are parallel to the section line on the east.  
All east-west lines are parallel to the center line of town 4 N. except  
the township line on the north, the line which is 33 feet north  
of this township line and the north line. Lots numbered from 13 to  
38 are each 120 feet wide by 241 2/3 feet long in east those numbered  
39, 41 and 42. All lots south of east 1/4 are each 120 feet wide except  
those numbered 13, 41 and 42. The other dimensions of lots are given on  
the plat. Lots numbered from 1 to 38 contain each 1 acre except those numbered  
11, 13, 41 and 42. The plat is drawn to a scale of 200 feet to 1 inch, and  
all distances on the plat are given in feet.

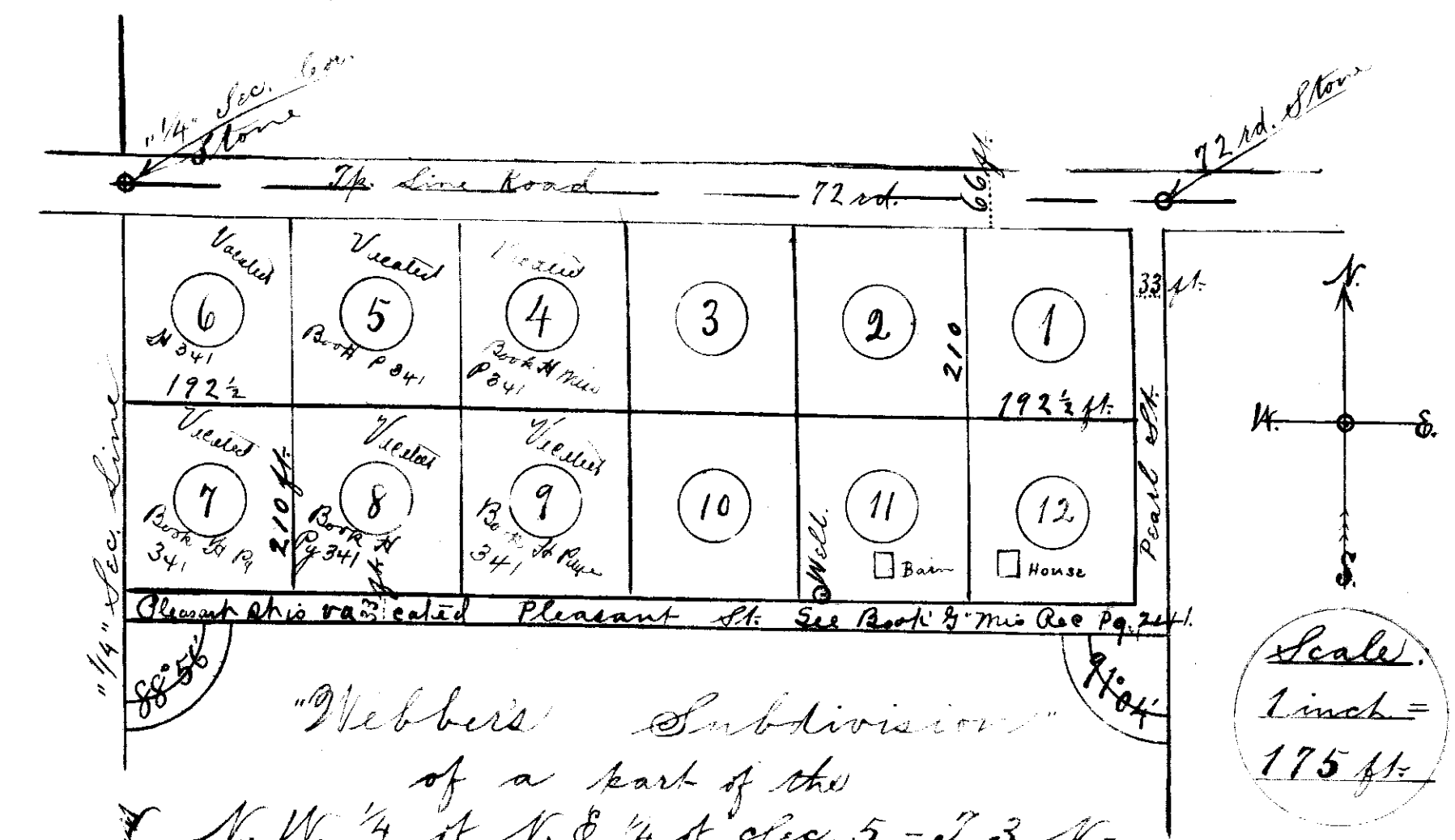
The above Plat with the foregoing description on
