Five & no/100 Dollars, in consideration of which the undersigned hereby grant and convey unto said Company, its associates and allied companies, its and their respective successors, assigns, lessees and agents, a right of way and easement to construct, operate, maintain, replace and remove such communication systems as the circumstances from time to time require, consisting of underground cables, wires, conduits, manholes, drains and splicing boxes, and surface testing terminals, repeaters and markers, and other appurtenances, upon, over and under a strip of land one rod wide across the land described in the instrument by which the undersigned have any interest in Section **3**, Township **148**, Range **12**, County **Colfax**, and State of **Nebraska**.

including the following rights: Of ingress and egress over and across said lands and unobliged to and from said strip for the purpose of exercising the rights herein granted; to place surface markers beyond said strip, to clear and keep cleared all trees, roots, brush and other obstructions from the surface and subsurface of said strip; to install gates in any fences crossing said strip; and to permit in said strip the cables, wires, circuits and appurtenances of any other company. The structure shall be treated or permitted on said strip. The grantees agree to pay for damage to fences and growing crops arising from the construction and maintenance of the aforesaid systems.
