This statement is made and entered into this 16th day of August, 1974, by and between Arthur S. and Irene M. Gifford, hereinafter called "OWNER", and the GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF FRANKTON, DODGE COUNTY, NEBRASKA, hereinafter called "CITY".

In consideration of valuable consideration \$1.00 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the OWNER hereby grants, conveys and transfers a line or lines for the transmission and distribution of electrical power, including the necessary poles, towers, wires, cables, fixtures, appliances, guy wires, supports, stumps and trees, upon which may prevent a hazard to the safe operation of said line or lines, through and over the following described real estate located in Country Club Estates Addition to Frankton, Nebraska:

Block 21: 5'-feet on either side of a common line between Lots 6 and 7; 10 and 11.

Block 22: 5'-feet on either side of a common line between Lots 16 and 17.

Block 41: 5'-feet on either side of a common line between Lots 5 and 6.

In witness whereof, we have written and set our hands this 16th day of August, 1974.

The CITY shall have the right of ingress and egress over the OWNER'S property for any purpose necessary in connection with the construction, operation, maintenance and inspection of said line or lines, and shall be liable to the OWNER for any reasonable damage which may be caused in exercising this right.

The CITY shall protect and indemnify and save harmless the OWNER from all claims, demands, suits, judgments, costs and expenses for losses, damages or injury to the person or property of any person or persons, having lawful right of being on the property, in any manner arising from or resulting out of the construction, extension, or use of said lines, unless such loss, damage or expense shall be due to the negligence or anyone other than the CITY.
