Lee Gendler, Trustee, hereinafter referred to as "Grantor", hereby grants and conveys to SANITARY AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 267 of Douglas County, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as "Grantee", a temporary and a permanent easement, as indicated on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, on which the Grantee may construct, reconstruct, maintain, and repair a storm sever construct, reconstruct, maintain, and repair a storm sewer line. Grantee shall have the right to enter upon said easement area at any time to inspect, construct, reconstruct, maintain and repair said sewer line.

The Grantee may use the temporary easement area during the time of the initial installation of the storm sewer line in the permanent easement area. However the temporary easement shall expire upon the completion of the initial installation of the sewer line.

After completion of the initial installation of the storm sewer line or after any subsequent entry on the easement area, Grantee shall repair or restore the easement area surface as nearly as possible to the condition existing prior to such entry.

Grantee agrees to perform any repair or maintenance necessary for the operation of the above mentioned storm sewer line. Grantee further agrees to repair any and all damages which may be caused by its use of the above described easement.

Grantee is solely responsible for constructing, operating, and maintaining the above-described improvements and Grantee shall indemnify and hold harmless the Grantor, its successors and assigns from any and all claims for personal injury or damage to property arising out of or in connection with the constructing, operating, or maintaining of the above described improvements.

Grantor agrees not to place any buildings or structures on the permanent easement area, but may place paving or plant grass, shrubs or crops on said area.

This easement grant shall run in favor and be binding upon the respective assigns, executors, administrators, heirs, devisees, successors, contractors, and agents of the Grantor and Grantee.


