WHEREAS, Charles L. and Jeanette Jensen, husband and wife, are the owners of the North Half (N 1/2) Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4), Section Nineteen (19), Township Eighteen (18), Range Twelve (12) East; and Clark and June Jenson, husband and wife are the owners of the South Half (S 1/2) Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) Section Nineteen (19) Township Eighteen (18), Range Twelve (12) East; and Herman J. and Vivian Kuhl, husband and wife are the owners of property located in the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) Section Nineteen (19), Township Eighteen (18), Range Twelve (12) East all in Washington County, Nebraska.

AND the parties hereto have agreed to construct and maintain a grade stabilization structure located on or near the property line in the Southeast Corner of the North Half Southwest Quarter (N 1/2 SW 1/4) above described. It is understood and agreed to by the grantors herein that the toe of the fill and the principle spillway will extend approximately 100 feet onto the Kuhl property; also the return flow through the emergency spillway will enter the Kuhl property south of the present drainageway.

THEREFORE, in consideration of the benefits to be derived by the grantors from the construction of said grade stabilization structure, Herman J. and Vivian Kuhl grant to Charles L. and Jeanette Jensen and Clark and June Jenson an easement over, across

and upon the property of the grantors for the purpose of constructing and maintaining said structure and expressly permit the location of a portion of the structure on their property.

GRANTEES shall have the right of ingress and egress over, upon and across said real estate for the purpose of constructing, maintaining or removing said works. This easement shall be binding on the grantors or their successors, heirs and assigns for an indefinite period of time, but shall lapse and have no force or effect whenever the works or construction are not used for the purpose or purposes originally intended by the parties.

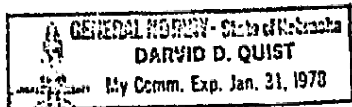
