ORDINANCE NO. 67

An ordinance vacating all alleys within Block FIFTY-SIX [56] of the Village OF BETHANY HEIGHTS, NEBRASKA.

Be it Ordained by the Chairman and board of VILLAGE TRUSTEES of the VILLAGE of BETHANY-HEIGHTS, NEBRASKA.

Section 1 That all alleys within Block Fifty Six [56] of the VILLAGE of BETHANY HEIGHTS, Lancaster County, Nebraska, be and the same are hereby vacated, and the area thus vacated shall revert to the owner of adjacent real estate, one half on either side of said alleys and each of them.

Section 2. If any citizen of the village of Bethany Heights, or if the owners of the property herein above described as block fifty six [56] of said Village, shall sustain any damage on account of the vacation of said alleys, they, or either of them, shall file an itemized statement of such damage with the Village Clerk of said village on or before the 1st day of April, 1925, and such claims shall be passed upon and disposed of as is now provided for the disposition of other claims filed against said village.

Section 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith be and the same are herewith repealed, Provided that the Bethany Heights, Nebraska shall have a perpetual easement to maintain operate, and construct, sewers water mains and pole lines in said alley.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication, according to law,
