AMENDMENT TO PROTECTIVE COVENANTS

KNOW ALL MEN BE THESE PRESENTS:

That whereas we, the undersigned, James A. Strauss and Mable I. Strauss, husband and wife, by instrument dated July 31, 1953, filed for record August 6, 1953 and duly recorded in Book 48 at Page 647 of Miscellaneous Records in the office of the Register of Deeds, Lancaster County, Nebraska, created, adopted and established certain building and use restrictions upon the following described real estate and property, to-wit:

All of Blocks 2 to 17 inclusive, Eastridge Addition to Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska; and whereas mone of said lots have been sold and the rights or interest of no other person or persons have intervened, and whereas we desire to amend said Protective Covenants with regard to the set back restrictions.

MOW THEREFORE, we, James A. Strauss and Mable I. Strauss, husband and wife, being the sole owners of the real estate and property hereinabove described, do hereby amend paragraph numbered 3 of some frettective Covenants so that said paragraph will read and provide as follows:

"3. No building shall be located on any lot earer than 30 feet to the front lot line, except that can comer lot, if the building is placed not hearer than 30 feet to the side street line, it has be placed not hearer than 20 feet to the front street line. No building shall be located hearer than o feet to any street or side lot line, except that a garage or other permitted accessory building located to feet or more from the front lot line has be located not hearer than 2 feet from any such street or side lot line. No dwelling shall be located on rear lot line. For the purpose of this covenant, as a part of a building; provided, however, that this building on a lot to encroach on another lot."

In all other respects the Irotective Covenants as originally created, adopted, established and recorded, shall remain in full force and effect.
