

DEDICATION

We, James A. Strauss and Mable D. Strauss, husband and wife, being sole owners and proprietors of the following tracts of land described as that part of Lot 40, Irregular Tracts in the south $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, T. 10 N.; R. 7 E.; and that part of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, T. 10 N.; R. 7 E.; of the 6th P.M., Lancaster County, Nebraska, described by metes and bounds as follows:-

Beginning at the S.E. corner of Lot 2, Block 17, "Eastridge Addition to Lincoln," Nebraska, running thence south along the east line of said Lot 40 a distance of 322.3 feet to the S.E. corner of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, thence south along the east line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 28 a distance of 248.4 feet; deflecting thence northwesterly at an angle of 124° 40' and running a distance of 408.1 feet, deflecting thence southwesterly at an angle of 96° 54' with last described line and running a distance of 358.3 feet; thence southwesterly and to the right along a curved line with a radius of 603.7 feet and central angle of 19° 46' right, a distance of 202.0 feet; thence southwesterly along a line tangent to last described curved line a distance of 217.9 feet; thence southwesterly and to the right along a curved line with a radius of 603.7 feet and a central angle of 20° 00' right a distance of 273.6 feet; thence southwesterly along a line tangent to last described curved line a distance of 54.0 feet; thence westerly and to the right along a curved line with a radius of 746.8 feet, and a central angle of 25° 30' right a distance of 305.3 feet; thence westerly along a line tangent to last described curved line a distance of 233.3 feet; thence northwesterly and to the right along a curved line the radius of which is 746.8 feet, and the central angle of 19° 30' right a distance of 253.8 feet; thence northwesterly along a line tangent to last described curved line a distance of 169.2 feet; deflecting thence northeasterly at an angle of 89° 12' right, a distance of 223.9 feet; deflecting thence southeasterly at an angle of 37° 21' right a distance of 204.9 feet; deflecting thence northeasterly at an angle of 99° 00' left, a distance of 171.7 feet; thence southeasterly 46.0 feet along a curved line, the radius of which is 249.0 feet, and central angle of 3° 06' to the right of the chord line, which is 46.0 feet in length, and deflects 85° 32' right from the last described tangent line; deflecting thence northeasterly at an angle of 98° 45' left from last described chord line a distance of 185.1 feet; deflecting thence northeasterly at an angle of 9° 12' right, a distance of 235.0 feet; deflecting thence northeasterly at an angle of 25° 12' right a distance of 210.3 feet; deflecting thence northwesterly at an angle of 45° 45' left a distance of 52.4 feet; deflecting thence northeasterly at an angle of 84° 26' right a distance of 125.5 feet; deflecting thence northeasterly at an angle of 57° 03' left, a distance of 315.6 feet; deflecting thence northwesterly at an angle of 7° 02' left, a distance of 26.1 feet, to the S.W. corner of Lot 1, Block 15, "Eastridge Addition to Lincoln," Nebraska, deflecting thence right and northeasterly at an angle of 82° 38' with last described line a distance of 774.8 feet; continuing northeasterly and deflecting 2° 03' right from last described line a distance of 454.4 feet; deflecting thence southerly at an angle of 100° 39' right along the west line of Sunrise Road a distance of 29.9 feet; deflecting thence left and easterly at an angle of 92° 13' a distance of 171.8 feet to point of beginning.

And now, we, the aforesaid undersigned sole owners and proprietors of the above described ground do hereby plat and dedicate the aforesaid same as "EASTRIDGE SECOND ADDITION" to Lincoln, Nebraska, and is with free consent in accordance with the desires of said owners and proprietors.
