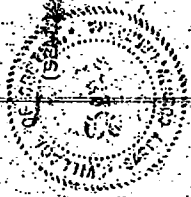

ORDINANCE NO. 97

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE NECESSITY FOR VACATING A PORTION OF LAURIE STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF GRETHA, PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THREE DESIGNATED RESIDENT APPRAISERS TO ASCERTAIN AND ASSESS THE DAMAGES THAT WILL BE SUSTAINED BY THE CITIZENS OF SAID VILLAGE OR BY THE OWNERS OR PROPERTY THEREIN BY REASON OF SAID VACATION, DETERMINING THEIR DUTIES, AND PROVIDING FOR THEIR COMPENSATION, PROVIDING WHEN SUCH VACATION PROCEEDINGS SHALL BE COMPLETE AND PROVIDING FOR THE ABANDONMENT OF SUCH PROCEEDINGS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Village of Gretha, Nebraska:

Section 1. It is hereby declared necessary, expedient, proper and for the public good to vacate Laurie Street in the Village of Gretha, Nebraska, from the south line extended of Angus Street, south to the south line extended of Lot 5, Fair Haven, an Addition to the Village of Gretha (being a street 55 feet in width east and west and 264 feet in width north and south).

Section 2. That the following named disinterested, resident freeholders are hereby appointed to ascertain and assess the damages that will be sustained by the citizens of the Village of Gretha, or by the owners of property therein by reason of such vacation.

Elmer Hansen

Charles Beettcher

That said appraisers shall meet within 15 days from the date hereof to ascertain and assess said damages, and within 20 days from date hereof shall file their written report and assessment with the Village Clerk; that said appraiser shall each receive the sum of \$5.00 per day as compensation for their services.

Section 3. The above vacation shall not be complete until payment of the appraiser's award, if any, and until the enactment by the Village of Gretha of a second or follow-up ordinance declaring such street or part of street vacated, failure to pay said award and enact such ordinance shall be conclusive evidence of the abandonment of the vacation proceedings.

ORDINANCE NO. 96

AN ORDINANCE LOCATING A PORTION OF LAUREL STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF GREYNA, ILLINOIS, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES TO THE CONTRARY THEREWITH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GREYNA, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That Laurel Street in the Village of Greyna, Macoupin County, Illinois, the north line extended of Angus Street, south to the south line extended of Lot 3, Fair Haven, in addition to the Village of Greyna (being a street 50 feet in width east and west and 20 feet in length north and south) be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That all Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
