ORDINANCE NO. 16061

01 AN ORDINANCE creating Water District No. 1143, providing for the
02 payments of the costs of the improvements therein, designating the property
03 to be benefited, providing for the acquisition of easements and additional
04 right-of-way, if necessary, and repealing all ordinances or parts of
05 ordinances in conflict herewith.

06 BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

07 Section 1. That Water District No. 1143 be and the same is hereby
08 created; that said water district is created for the purpose of constructing
09 a 6-inch diameter main or water mains in Southwest 9th Street from West South
10 Street north approximately 550 feet, in said City; and that said district
11 shall include the following described real estate benefited, to-wit: All that
12 portion of Lot 173 lying within 180.0 feet east of the centerline of Southwest
13 9th Street except the north 125.0 feet thereof, ~~and except that portion lying~~
14 ~~within 180.0 feet north of the centerline of West South Street;~~ and all that
15 portion of Lots ^{175,} 74, 75, 76 and 78 lying within 180.0 feet west of the
16 centerline of Southwest 9th Street; all Irregular Tracts located in the
17 Northwest Quarter of Section 34, Township 10 North, Range 6 East of the Sixth
18 Principal Meridian in the City of Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska.

19 The cost of constructing said water mains, including the cost of fire
20 plugs, valves, and all other expenses incidental to said improvements, shall
21 be assessed against the property benefited in said district, not exceeding
22 the special benefits accruing on account thereof. In the event that easements
23 or additional right-of-way must be acquired for the completion of this
24 district, such property rights may be acquired by negotiation and purchase or
25 by condemnation, if necessary, as provided by law.

02 herewith, be and the same hereby are repealed.
03 Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and
04 after its passage and publication according to law, but construction shall
05 not be commenced until ordered by resolution by the City Council.


