DEVELOPER'S AMENDMENT TO DECLARATION OF SUBMISSION  
OF PROPERTY TO HORIZONTAL PROPERTY REGIME FOR  
FOREST GLEN CONDOMINIUMS, COUNCIL BLUFFS, IOWA

The undersigned, Tweedt Engineering & Construction, Inc., a corporation referred to as "developer" in the declaration of submission of property to horizontal property regime for Forest Glen Condominiums, Council Bluffs, Iowa, hereby amends that declaration of submission of property to horizontal property regime pursuant to Articles IX and X of that declaration as follows:

ARTICLE XXII

The council of co-owners shall act as the titleholder or lot owner of the property for the purposes of satisfying the conditions, restrictions, limitations and reservations of the restrictive covenants filed as a part of the final platting of Forest Glen Subdivision, Phase II. Those restrictive covenants were dated August 31, 1992, and were recorded October 12, 1992, in Book 93 at Page 10391 of the records of the Pottawattamie County Recorder.

Furthermore, Article VI, Section 2, paragraph heading is hereby amended to read as follows: Other Provisions for First Lienholders.
