# PARTIAL RELEASE AND MODIFICATION OF RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT

THIS INDENTURE, made this <u>//</u> day of <u>April</u>, 1968, by and between MOBIL PIPE LINE COMPANY, a Texas corporation, First Party; and MICHAEL T. LEVY, Trustee, Second Party.

# WITNESSETH:

THAT, WHEREAS, on the 20th day of February, 1941, Fannie P. Haller, a widow, executed and delivered to Socony-Vacuum Oil Company, Inc., First Party's predecessor, a certain right of way agreement which was filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds, Douglas County, Nebraska, May 1, 1941, in Book 155 of Misc., page 82, granting a right of way easement for a pipeline over the following described land in Douglas County, Nebraska, to-wit:

West Half of Block 224 in Florence, addition to the City of Omaha, Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, all rights granted by the aforementioned right of way agreement are now owned by MOBIL PIPE LINE COMPANY; and

WHEREAS, Second Party has requested First Party to relocate and lower its pipeline and release its right of way easement with the exception of a strip of land thirty (30) feet in width, the exact legal description of said strip of land being hereinafter more specifically described; and

Second Party hereby grants and conveys unto First Party, its successors and assigns, the right of way, easements and privileges to lay, repair, maintain, operate and remove pipelines, whether one or more, and from time to time, and replace existing lines with other lines, for the transportation of oil and gas, and the products thereof, water, or any other fluid or substance, and to erect, repair, maintain, operate and remove graphite and steel anodes and other devices for the control of pipeline corrosion, over, across and through the above-described tract, with ingress and egress to and from the same.

It is expressly understood that First Party shall have an exclusive easement free and clear of buildings or other obstructions; however, Second Party shall have the right to pave said easement area but, in the event it becomes necessary to gain access to its easement area, First Party may remove the paving and any expense for re-paving shall be borne by Second Party, his heirs or assigns.

First Party agrees that, should it become necessary, it will lower its line to a depth mutually acceptable to both parties, cost of such adjustment to be borne by Second Party, his heirs or assigns. Payment for said adjustment shall be made by certified check in the amount of a prepared estimate. After all work has been completed, Second Party will be invoiced the actual cost up to the estimated cost and a refund will be made for the difference, if applicable.

Said right of way, easements and privileges herein granted each being divisible and assignable or transferable, in whole or in part, to have and to hold the same unto First Party, its successors and assigns, for so long as used for purposes aforesaid.

This agreement shall be binding on the heirs, representatives, successors and assigns of the respective parties hereto.



South of the NWcorner of Lot 224. This strip of land, 35 ft. wide and 4,075.9 ft. long contains 3.275 Acres, more or less.

This description is in accordance with a legal survey made by Mr. Wm. H. Scott which was completed November 30, 1956 and platted on Drawing No. 56303-1. This Drawing is included herewith as part of this instrument.

Second Parties further agree that after the First Party has lowered its pipe line to comply with street and lot grade contour, such contour having been accepted and approved by the Omaha Planning Commission and City Engineer, First Party shall be relieved of any further expense of lowering or altering its pipe line across such approved platted subdivision.







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#### AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 2 day of 1968, between MICHAEL T. LEVY, TRUSTEE, hereinafter referred to as OWNER (whether one or more), and MOBIL PIPE LINE COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Texas, hereinafter referred to as MOBIL;

#### WITNESSETH:

That WHEREAS, MOBIL PIPE LINE COMPANY by virtue of an agreement dated January 2, 1957, recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Nebraska, in Book 317, Page 193, is the owner and holder of a right of way and easement for pipe lines and other purposes through certain land in the original town of Florence, now a part of the City of Omaha, as surveyed, platted, and recorded, and being located in the Southeast Quarter (SE/4) of Section 29 and the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of Section 28, Township 16 North, Range 13 East, and by reference to said easement and the record thereof, said easement is incorporated herein for all purposes as if the same were copied herein in its entirety; and

WHEREAS, the Owner referred to herein is the present owner of a tract of land described as being the West Half of a portion of 31st Street vacated and the East 58.75 feet of Block 219 in Florence Addition to the City of Omaha, Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, OWNER has requested MOBIL to amend its right of way easement and relocate its pipe line through said tract of land to a tract of land hereinafter described upon which pipe lines and/or other equipment are to be located.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual benefits and obligations of the parties resulting from the covenants herein, the parties do hereby agree as follows:

- 1. MOBIL does hereby remise, release, and forever quitclaim unto OWNER that 35 foot wide strip of land as described in Agreement dated January 2, 1957 referred to above, insofar and only insofar as it applies to said strip of land located in the West Half of 31st Street vacated and the East 58.75 feet of Block 219 in Florence Addition to the City of Omaha, Nebraska.
- OWNER hereby grants and conveys unto MOBIL, its successors and assigns, the rights of way, easements and privileges to lay, repair, maintain,

operate and remove pipe lines and replace existing lines with other lines, for the transportation of oil and gas, and the products thereof, water, or any other fluid or substance, together with such drips, valves, fittings, meters, and similar appurtenances as may be necessary or convenient to the operation of said lines, on, over, or through those certain lands situated in Douglas County, Nebraska, described as follows:

The West Half of a portion of 31st Street vacated and the East 58.75 feet of Block 219 in Florence Addition to the City of Omaha. Said right of way granted herein being 30 feet in width and being 15 feet on each side of the following described centerline:

BEGINNING at a point in a line being the centerline of 31st Street vacated (82.5 feet in width), said point being Southerly a distance of 20.3 feet from the South line of Weber Street in the original town of Florence, now a part of the City of Omaha, in the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of Section 28, Township 16 North, Range 13 East of the 6th P.M., Douglas County, Nebraska;

THENCE South 78° 00' 15" West a distance of 100 feet more or less to a point in a line being the West line of the East 58.75 feet of Block 219, said point being Southerly 20.5 feet from a 3/4" iron rod marking the Northwest Corner of said East 58.75 feet of said Block 219, being in all a total distance of 100 feet, or 6.06 rods, more or less,

with ingress and egress to and from the same.

- 3. It is hereby mutually agreed that any gate valve or similar appurtenance provided for in the paragraph above, which will be located above ground, will be located within the West 25 feet of the right of way described above.
- 4. It is expressly understood and agreed that except for existing easement rights now owned by others, if any, MOBIL, its successors and assigns, shall have an exclusive easement across and over the right of way strip described above, and said easement strip shall remain free and clear of buildings or other obstructions; however, OWNER shall have the right to pave said easement area sufficient to permit it to be used as a parking area, but in the event it becomes necessary in order to enjoy the privileges granted to it herein, MOBIL may remove the paving and, in so doing, shall incur no responsibility or obligation for restoring the paving nor liability for any damages because of such removal.
- 5. MOBIL agrees that it will remove its pipe line now located on said property and will reconstruct its pipe line on the easement granted herein.

Such line to be buried to a depth mutually acceptable to both parties, and the total cost of such removal and construction is to be borne by OWNER, his heirs or assigns. Payment for the cost of said work shall be made by certified check payable to MOBIL in the amount of prepared cost estimates of said work, and, after all work has been completed, OWNER will be invoiced for the actual cost of the work, and, if the estimated cost and the amount of the certified check exceeds the actual cost, then MOBIL will refund the difference to OWNER.

This Agreement shall be binding on the heirs, representatives, successors and assigns of the respective parties hereto.

Right of Way Agreement dated January 2, 1957, referred to above, shall remain in full force and effect except as amended hereby.



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


