RELINQUISHMENT INSTRUMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads, pursuant to the provisions of Statute No's. 39-1313 and 39-1314 of Revised Statutes of Nebraska, (1943) does hereby relinquish, subject to the reservations and conditions hereinafter set forth, to the City of Bellevue the following described realty, situated in the City of Bellevue, Sarpy County, Nebraska, to-wit:

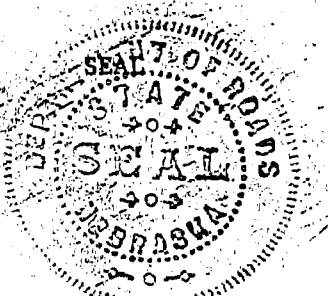
A strip of roadway previously occupied by Highway No. 133 located in the city of Bellevue, Nebraska. This was originally platted as a portion of Galvin Road beginning at the south limits of Georgia Avenue and the east limits of Highway No. 73-75 and running thence southeasterly along said portion of Galvin Road to the north limits of Harvel Road and the north right of way of the new location of Highway No. 133.

The reservations and conditions are herewith set forth: The City will maintain said roadway. The City will prohibit advertising and disposal of junk and related material on said portion of old highway.
