





**ABSTRACT**  
 ALL MEN OF THESE PREMISES: That W. H. BIRDS INVESTMENT, INC. is a Nebraska corporation, and FRANK BRECK and JUDITH BRECK (husband and wife), PAUL BRECK and MARY ALICE BRECK (husband and wife), ROBERT SHROPP and LOUISE SHROPP (husband and wife), GEORGE D. BROWN and GEORGE W. VETTERBERG (husband and wife), and ANNA G. ROOSEBOLD (widow), and WASHINGTON NATIONAL BANK in Omaha, Nebraska, in Nebraska corporation, together, being respectively, the sole owners and mortgage holder of the land described within the hereinafter certificate and entered within this plat, have caused said land to be subdivided into lots and streets, to be conveyed and named as shown, said subdivision to be hereinafter known as (116192) BIRDS, BROWN, SHROPP and ROOSEBOLD PLAT, for the Omaha Public Power District and the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, their successors and assigns, to erect and operate, maintain, repair and renew cables, conductors, and poles with the necessary appurtenances, including the streets and easements as shown on this plat. We do hereby grant a perpetual license in favor of said district and company, their successors and assigns, to use and occupy the poles and wires on the streets and easements as shown on this plat, and to install, maintain, repair and renew the same, and to use the same for the transmission of electric current for light, heat and power, and for all telephone and telegraph and message service over, upon, or under a right-of-way of said streets, and also boundary lines of said lots (these easements apply only to land within said subdivision), said license being granted for the use and benefit of said present and future owners of lots in said subdivision provided, however, that said site for line easement shall be granted on the specific condition that if both said utility companies fail to construct poles, wires or conductors along any of said site lot lines within the months of the date hereof, or if any poles, wires or conductors are constructed but hereafter removed without replacement within 60 days after their removal, then this site lot line easement shall automatically terminate and become void as to such interest or abandoned easement. No permanent easement shall be created in, upon or over any of the lots or easements shown on this plat, except as herein provided, and the utility act and deed of said corporation, and the utility act and deed of said bank.
