cables, conduit, and other necessary appurtenances, beneath, upon,  
and across the following described land which they

Own(s),  
or in which they  
have any interest, in the County of Washington,  
State of Nebraska, to-wit: A parcel of land 40x40 feet in  
width in E1/4 NE1/4 E1/4 NW1/4 E1/4 SW1/4, Section 12, T-17n, R9E, Washington County,  
Nebraska.

Said buried cable facilities to be located so far as  
practical on approximately the following course: an irregular course  
in the SE corner of the above described property, also containing a  
buried pedestal - 3 feet deep.

The Arlington  
Telephone Company agrees to pay for loss of crops due to  
construction or maintenance within this easement.

This easement includes the right of ingress to and egress  
from said land at any time for the purpose of exercising any  
of the rights herein granted.

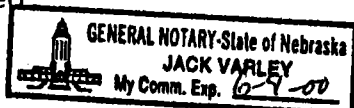
