## SPECIAL PERMIT NO. 706E

WHEREAS, Fountain Glen Partnership, has submitted an application designated as Special Permit No. 706E for authority to amend the Highland Glen Community Unit Plan to eliminate two proposed sidewalks and foot bridges accessing the apartment complex from the south and west. Said Highland Glen Community Unit Plan is generally located at Northwest 2nd Circle and West Fletcher Avenue on property legally described to wit:

Lots 1 through 20, Highland Glen 1st
Addition and Lot 1, Highland Glen 2nd
Addition, Lincoln, Lancaster County,
Nebraska.

WHEREAS, the real property adjacent to the area included within the plot plan for this elimination of said required sidewalks and foot bridges will not be adversely affected; and

WHEREAS, said plot plan together with the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth are consistent with the intent and purpose of Title 27 of the Lincoln Municipal Code to promote the public health, safety, morals, and general welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

That the application of Fountain Glen Partnership, hereinafter referred to as "Permittee", to eliminate said sidewalks and foot bridges described above be and the same is hereby granted under the provisions of Section 27.65.060 of the Lincoln Municipal Code upon condition that elimination of said sidewalks and foot bridges from said Highland Glen Community Unit

 Plan be in strict compliance with said application, the plot plan, and the following additional express terms, conditions, and requirements:

- 1. This permit approves the elimination of the two proposed sidewalks from the single family residential area to the west and from West Fletcher Avenue and the associated bridges crossing the low flow liner. All other terms, conditions and requirements of the original special permit for Highland Glen Community Plan shall remain in effect.
- Permittee shall provide profiles for the sidewalk from West Fletcher Avenue to document the lack of accessibility.
- 3. The terms, conditions, and requirements of this resolution shall be binding and obligatory upon the Permittee, successors, and its assigns. The building official shall report violations to the City Council which may revoke the special permit amendment or take such other action as may be necessary to gain compliance.
- 4. The Permittee shall sign and return the City's letter of acceptance to the City Clerk within 30 days following approval of this amendment to the special permit, provided, however, said 30-day period may be extended up to six months by administrative amendment. The City Clerk shall file a copy of the resolution approving the amendment to the special permit and the letter of acceptance with the Register of Deeds, filing fees therefor to be paid in advance by the Permittee.
