A tract of land located in the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 1, Township 15 North, Range 11 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Douglas County, Nebraska, described as follows:

Referring to the Southeast Corner of said Quarter Quarter Section; thence northerly a distance of 91.49 feet along the East Line of said Quarter Quarter Section to the point of beginning; thence westerly deflecting 077 degrees, 17 minutes, 51 seconds left, a distance of 391.86 feet; thence westerly deflecting 012 degrees, 43 minutes, 23 seconds left, a distance of 300.04 feet; thence westerly deflecting 012 degrees, 10 minutes, 45 seconds left, a distance of 308.06 feet; thence easterly deflecting 166 degrees, 34 minutes, 46 seconds left, a distance of 983.64 feet to the point of beginning, containing 48,112.34 square feet, more or less.

There will be no ingress or egress from said Highway 64 (West Maple Road) to the property described above. The intent being to deny entry and exit from said property.

In accordance with Article III, Section 20 of the Constitution of the State of Nebraska, the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads does hereby retain and reserve to itself all salt springs, coal, oil, gas, natural resources or other mineral rights it may have in or on the above described real property.

The grantees, for themselves, their heirs, personal representatives, successors in interest, and assigns, as a part of the consideration hereof, does hereby further covenant and agree "as a covenant running with the land" (1) that the land herein conveyed or any part hereof shall not be used for the erection or display of any advertising sign, device or display, which is not related to or connected with the use of the premises conveyed hereby; (2) that the land herein conveyed shall not be used for the storage, processing, sorting, transfer or any other use related to or connected with scrap material of any nature or kind; or any other use, which would create or cause an unsightly or obnoxious appearance upon the premises herein conveyed.

The State of Nebraska, Department of Roads, reserves an easement for the operation, maintenance and use of any and all existing utilities which are located over, under or upon the above described tract.

The State reserves to itself a permanent easement over which the various impacts, including but not limited to, noise, air, light, and dust, associated with vehicular traffic on the highway may be disbursed.


The Grantees, for themselves, their heirs, personal representatives, successors in interest and assigns, as part of the consideration hereof, do hereby further covenant and agree to provide for Protective Covenants to be included in a plating of the area between 138th Street and 142nd Street along and North of Highway 64 (West Maple Road), City of Omaha, Douglas County, Nebraska. The purpose of said covenant shall be to allow NO residential construction less than 205 feet from the centerline of Highway 64 (West Maple Road) as shown on Project F-64-7(102), said plans being on file with the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads. This restriction shall apply only to inhabited portions of residences, but not to related accessory improvements.
