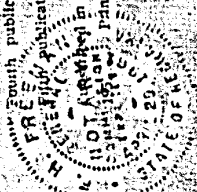

ORDINANCE NO. 47  
 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
 ORDINANCE NUMBER 39 OF  
 THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, NE-  
 BRASKA  
 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE  
 MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF  
 THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, NE-  
 BRASKA:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance number 39 of the City of Bellevue, Nebraska, is hereby amended to read as follows: There is hereby reserved to the City of Bellevue and its successors the right to use a strip of land 5 feet in width on each side of the center line of that portion of Clay Street hereby vacated between 20th Avenue and Hopland Drive and a strip of land 5 feet in width on the west side of the center line of that portion of Clay Street hereby vacated between Hopland Drive and 2nd Avenue and also a strip of land 5 feet in width on each side of the center line of that portion of Clay Street hereby vacated

declared as being 5 feet in width on each side of the projected rear lot line of Lots 14 and 15, in Hopkins Addition and Lots 30, 31 and 46, in Hopkins Second Addition, for municipal improvements which are hereby declared to be sewers and utilities only.

Section 2. That in all other respects said Ordinance shall remain as originally passed and approved on March 26, 1915, and that all ordinances and parts of ordinances passed and approved prior to the passage and approval of this ordinance and in conflict therewith are hereby repealed.  
 Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law. Passed and approved this 7th day of May, 1919.

ORDINANCE NO. 407

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 399 OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, NEBRASKA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 399 OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, NEBRASKA, IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

THERE IS HEREBY RESERVED TO THE CITY OF BELLEVUE AND ITS APPOINTEES THE RIGHT TO USE A STRIP OF LAND 5 FEET IN WIDTH ON EACH SIDE OF THE CENTER LINE OF THAT PORTION OF CLAY STREET HEREBY VACATED BETWEEN 29TH AVENUE AND HOPKINS DRIVE AND A STRIP OF LAND 5 FEET IN WIDTH ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE CENTER LINE AND 9 FEET IN WIDTH ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE CENTER LINE OF THAT PORTION OF CLAY STREET HEREBY VACATED BETWEEN HOPKINS DRIVE AND 32ND AVENUE AND ALSO A STRIP OF LAND ACROSS THOSE PORTIONS OF CLAY STREET HEREBY VACATED AND DESCRIBED AS BEING 5 FEET IN WIDTH ON EACH SIDE OF THE PROJECTED REAR LOT LINE OF LOTS 1, 14, AND 15, IN HOPKINS ADDITION AND LOTS 30, 31 AND 40, IN HOPKINS SECOND ADDITION, FOR MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENTS WHICH ARE HEREBY DECLARED TO BE SEWERS AND UTILITIES ONLY.

SECTION 2. THAT IN ALL OTHER RESPECTS SAID ORDINANCE SHALL REMAIN AS ORIGINALLY PASSED AND APPROVED ON MARCH 28, 1955, AND THAT ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES PASSED AND APPROVED PRIOR TO THE PASSAGE AND APPROVAL OF THIS ORDINANCE AND IN CONFLICT THEREWITH ARE HEREBY REPEALED.

SECTION 3. THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE AND BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE, APPROVAL AND PUBLICATION AS PROVIDED BY LAW.
