KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

In consideration of the performance of the terms and conditions of the Sale of Facilities Agreement between Nebraska Public Power District and Omaha Public Power District effective the 1st day of February, 1982, the Nebraska Public Power District (NPPD), Columbus, Nebraska, a public corporation and political subdivision of the State of Nebraska, and as successor in interest to Loup River Public Power District, Columbus, Nebraska, in the right of way easements described herein, does hereby grant, sell, assign and deliver unto the Gmaha Public Power District (OPPD), Omaha, Nebraska, a public corporation and political subdivision of the State of Nebraska, its successors and assigns, assignment of such portion of the right of way easements described on Exhibit A, attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof, sufficient for OPPD to construct, maintain, operate, inspect, alter or repair an electric transmission line together with such other rights as are contained in said right of way easements sufficient to effectuate the Sale of Facilities Agreement between NPPD and OPPD.

Provided, that if OPPD removes or abandons its right to construct, maintain, operate, inspect, alter or repair an electric transmission line over said right of way easements, then so much of the rights granted herein as are necessary for NPPD to continue its existing right to construct, maintain, operate, inspect,

alter or repair an electric transmission line over said right of way easements shall revert to and be vested in NPPD, and if NPPD removes or abandons its right to construct, maintain, operate, inspect, alter or repair an electric transmission line over said right of way easements, then so much of the rights in said right of way easements as are necessary for OPPD to continue to construct, maintain, operate, inspect, alter or repair an electric transmission line over said right of way easements are assigned, transferred and delivered to OPPD.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the assignment of the right of way easements as described in the Exhibit attached hereto unto OPPD, its successors and assigns forever.
