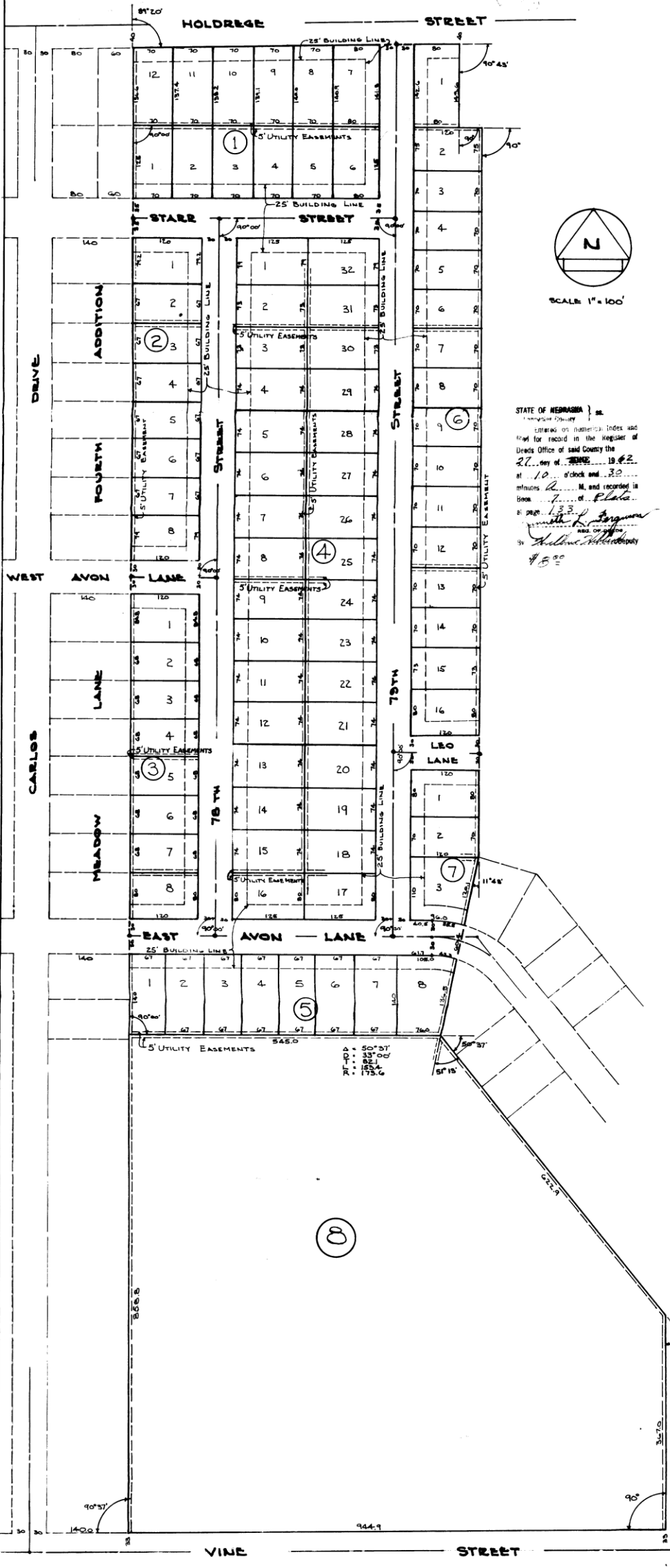

DEDICATION

We, The First Continental National Bank and Trust Company, Trustee, a Corporation, being sole owner and proprietor of that part of the N.E. 1/4 of Section 22, T.16 N.; R.7 E. of the 6th P.M. Lancaster County, Nebraska, described as, Beginning at a point 170 feet East and 33 feet North of the Southwest Corner of the N.E. 1/4 of said Section 22, running thence North along East line of "Meadow Lane Fourth Addition" a distance of 2590.4 feet to a point 33 feet South of the North line of said Section 22, running thence East and parallel to the North line of Section 22 a distance of 570 feet; deflecting thence right 90°45' and running a distance of 150.0 feet; deflecting thence left 90°00' and running a distance of 400 feet; deflecting thence right 90°00' and running a distance of 1278.0 feet; deflecting thence right 11°45' and running a distance of 317.0 feet; deflecting thence left 51°15' and running a distance of 622.0 feet; deflecting thence right 35°45' and running a distance of 367.0 feet; deflecting thence right 90°00' and running a distance of 944.0 feet to point of beginning, do hereby plat and dedicate the aforesaid same as "Meadow Lane Fifth Addition to Lincoln, Nebraska," and in with free consent and in accordance with the desires of said owners and proprietors.

All Streets shown thereon are hereby dedicated to the use of the public, together with easements for the construction of sewers, conduits and pole lines in the various locations shown on the plat.
